1. Call to Order.

Co-Chairperson Benelli called the meeting to order.

2. Approval of Minutes from August 10, 2017 Meeting.

It was moved by Committeemember Villanueva-Saucedo, seconded by Committeemember Brown, that the minutes from the Imagine Mesa Advisory Committee held on August 10, 2017 be approved.

Co-Chairperson Benelli declared the motion carried unanimously by those present.

Carried Unanimously.

3. Hear a Presentation and Discuss the Recommendations to be Delivered to City Council.

Co-Chairperson Leyba explained that in December 2017 the Committee will present a PowerPoint presentation to Council regarding the Imagine Mesa ideas grouped by vision, forum, and alpha order. He noted that the committee will outline the process and identify ideas that the community supports.

4. Discuss and Provide Direction on Advisory Committee Meeting Schedule and Subcommittee Development.

Co-Chairperson Benelli explained that the timeframe for determining ideas has been shortened due to Council's winter break schedule. She noted that the ideas will need to be presented to Council in early December.

Chief of Staff Ian Linssen stated that currently the Imagine Mesa website has 395 ideas.

Co-Chairperson Benelli suggested that the committee split into four sub-committees.

Chief Digital Officer Julia Thompson displayed the 395 draft Imagine Mesa ideas and pointed out that the ideas have been grouped into four sections: play, home, green future, and work and innovation. She noted that each section has listed the number of themed ideas that is bolded then grouped with sub-ideas as well as the total number of votes for each. She highlighted the top five ideas in each section and emphasized that the list is a tool to assist the sub-committees in narrowing down the ideas. **(See Attachment 1)**

In response to questions posed by Committeemember Villanueva-Saucedo, Ms. Thompson responded that the first column on the list represents the location on the website. She clarified that the website ideas will not be moved, that the ideas had a common theme, and confirmed that there are no duplications within the four sections.

In response to a question from Committeemember Villanueva-Saucedo, Principal Planner Tom Ellsworth replied that he will research the Google drive calendar so that Committeemembers can view the current list of Imagine Mesa ideas.

Co-Chairperson Leyba pointed out that each sub-committee will have a staff liaison to pose questions/clarifications specific to the listed ideas.

Ms. Thompson introduced Performance Administrator Janet Woolum, who is assisting in organizing the sub-committees.

Ms. Woolum stated that she will be the facilitator of the sub-committees and will assist in discussions moving forward. She explained that the sub-committees are to be formed through a self-selection process and asked the Committeemembers to choose two of the four committees they would prefer to serve on.

Co-Chairperson Benelli highlighted meeting times and the number of meetings prior to the December presentation to Council. She suggested that the first sub-committee meeting be held by October 5, 2017 and the last meeting by November 30, 2017. She added that all sub-committees will meet on the same night and time and listed the following dates/times:

- October 5 and 19, 2017 at 5:30 p.m.
- November 2 and 16, 2017 at 5:30 p.m.

Co-Chairperson Benelli clarified that November 9 and 16, 2017 would likely be Advisory Board Committee meetings. She confirmed that November 30, 2017 will be the final Advisory Board

Committee meeting prior to the Council presentation in December. She clarified that if sub-committees need additional meetings before November 30, 2017 that they arrange those.

Discussion ensued relative to minute taking, use of staff liaisons, postings, and quorums of the sub-committee meetings.

5. Discuss and Provide Direction on the use of Success Factors and Subcommittees to Evaluate Ideas.

Co-Chairperson Leyba explained that the sub-committee meetings will discuss success factors which the committee will create today and outlined what the sub-committee meetings may entail:

- First meeting – Review ideas and request additional information
- Second meeting – Receive information and have further discussion
- Third meeting – Complete evaluation and provide information to the full Committee

Discussion ensued relative to ranking and organizing the evaluations, remaining consistent within each of the four sub-committees, and evaluating ideas based on success factors.

Ms. Woolum asked the committee to list potential success factors and the following list was discussed:

- Does City own the property
- General financial burden
- Interest from the public
- Time table for completion
- Require a bond
- Impact
- Competing ideas
- Partnerships
- Is it already in progress/planned
- Requires a partner (can City do it alone)
- Return on Investment (ROI)
- Proximity to other facilities
- Ongoing costs

Committeemember Arnett stated that the sub-committees should consider the feasibility of an idea, explore ideas outside the box, and to consider possible partnerships.

Ms. Woolum outlined the impact/effort matrix which is a high-low impact and high-low effort on a graph chart and explained a scenario with a number ranking on each axis.

Ms. Woolum confirmed that the sub-committee will use the success factors as a checklist first to narrow down the ideas and then utilize the impact/effort matrix. She added that the checklist will be reviewed and available at all sub-committee meetings as well as an electronic version of the matrix that will be available on the Google drive.

6. Committee Member Updates.

Management Associate Jeffrey Robbins reviewed the Executive Dashboard, which includes totals for visitors, which forums are being visited the most, the top five ideas by vision forum, and age groups. He pointed out that the original goal for total visitors was 10,000, however, the visits have surpassed that goal and the total is now over 30,000 visitors. **(See Attachment 2)**

Mr. Robbins clarified that the number of total contributors indicates that the advertising efforts are working. He explained that staff is working with a consultant, Ideas Collide, LLC, that targeted ads about Imagine Mesa to encourage people to visit the website. He noted that over the last couple of weeks over 1,000 people have visited the site.

Ms. Thompson reviewed the target groups and highlighted the campaign specific to Spanish speakers stating that this group has been more engaged and that the target areas are refined every couple of weeks.

Mr. Robbins explained that staff has organized a high school challenge to encourage students to log into the Imagine Mesa website. He noted that staff is working with the six Mesa High Schools, specifically with student councils and through a partnership with the Chamber of Commerce. He added that the challenge offers \$2,000 to the student council that reaches out to the site to achieve the most “Me Too’s” for their school. He added that a separate tab will be created on the website as a “Mascot Challenge”, as well as having additional information to guide students to see ideas on the website for further interaction.

Mr. Robbins displayed a heat map showing where the contributors are coming from specific to the zip code areas. He stated that staff will provide the map to the committee.

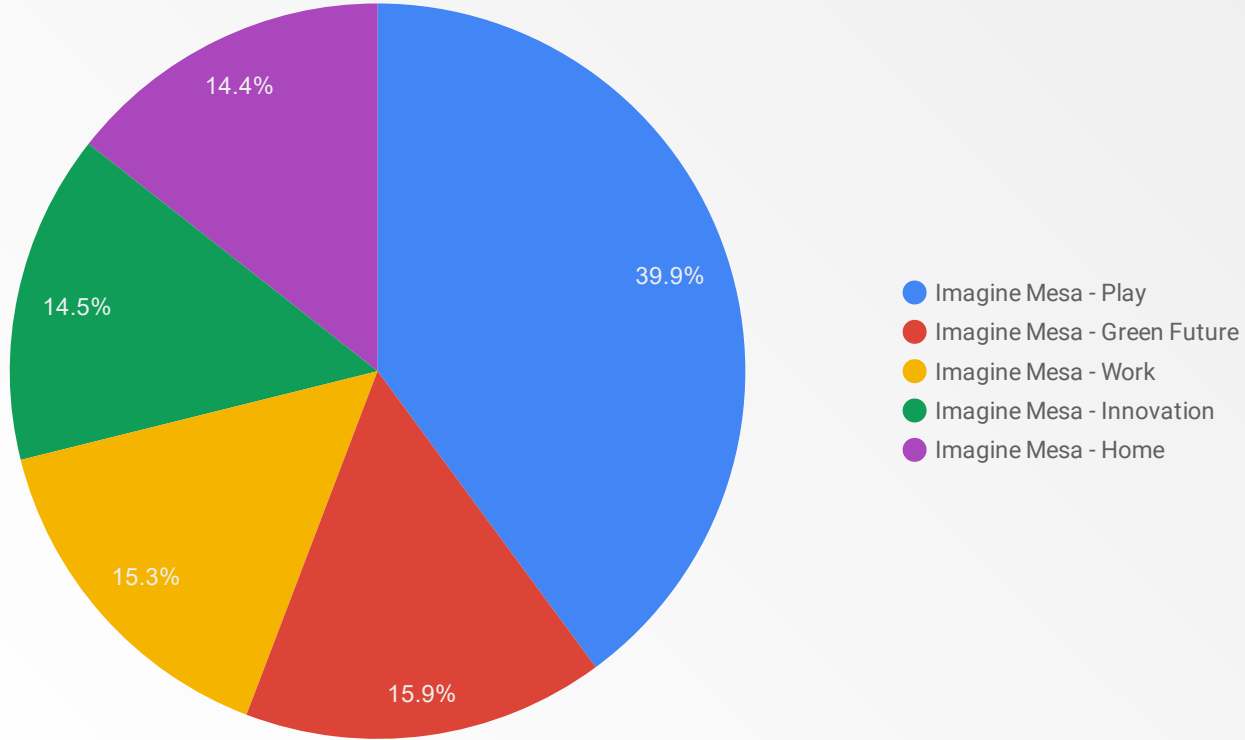

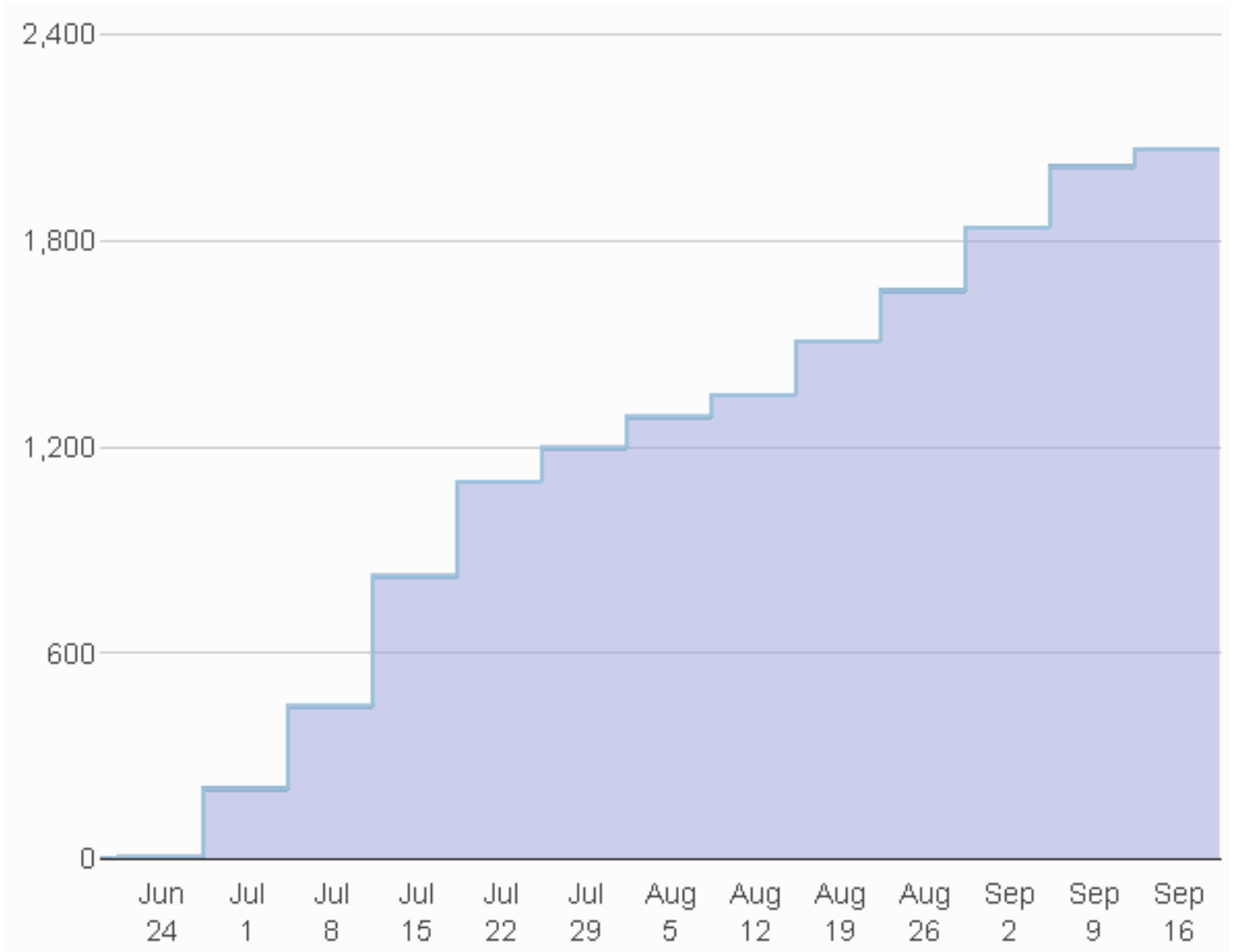

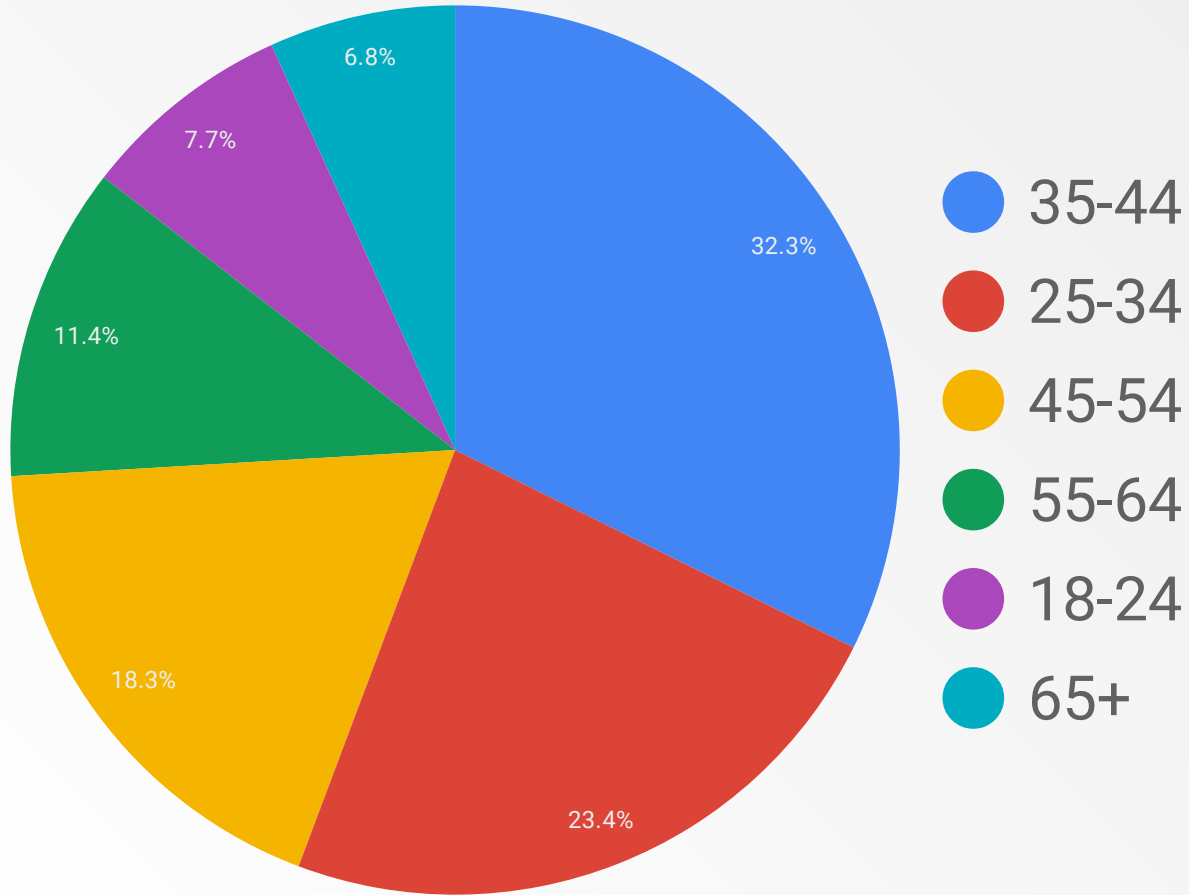

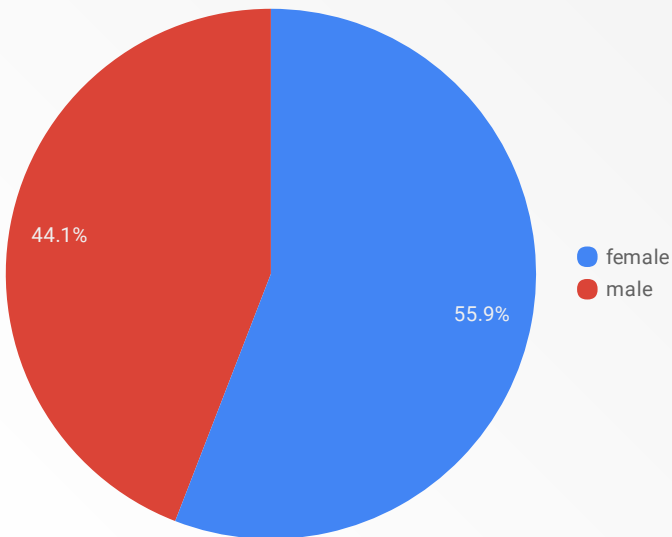
## What age groups do site visitors fall into?

Showing the age distribution of site visitors



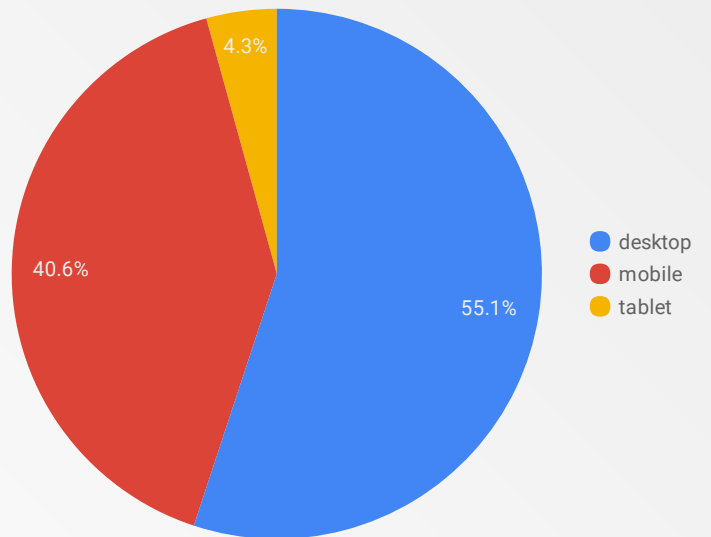
## What gender do site visitors fall into?

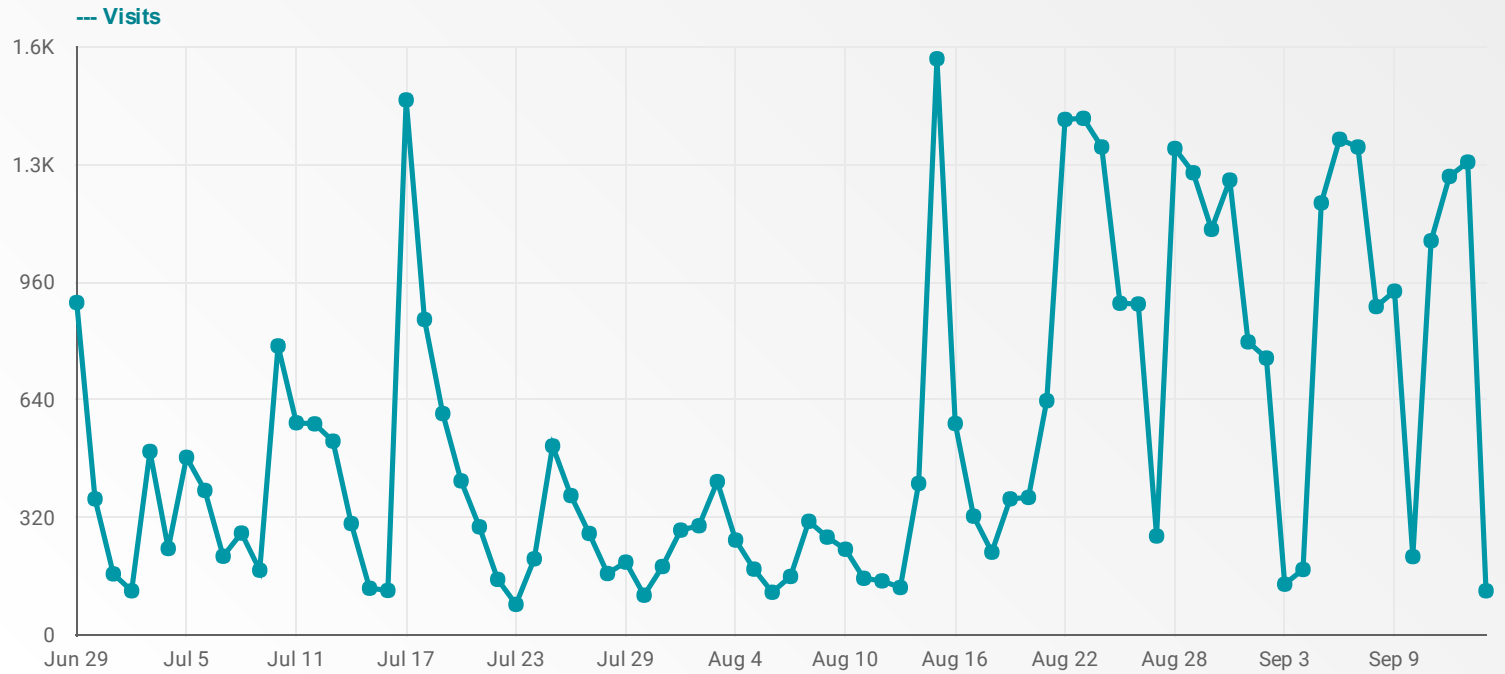

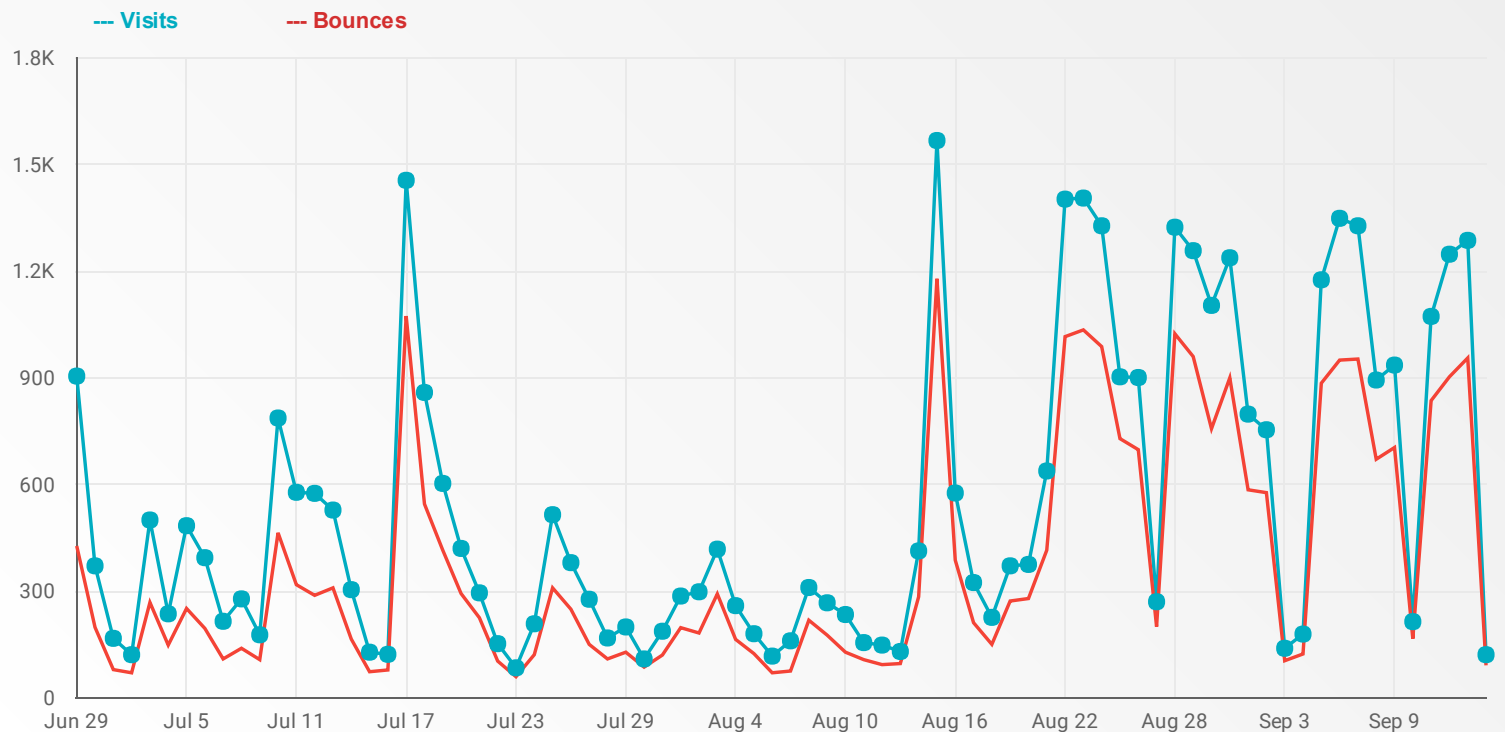
Selected date range vs. previous period

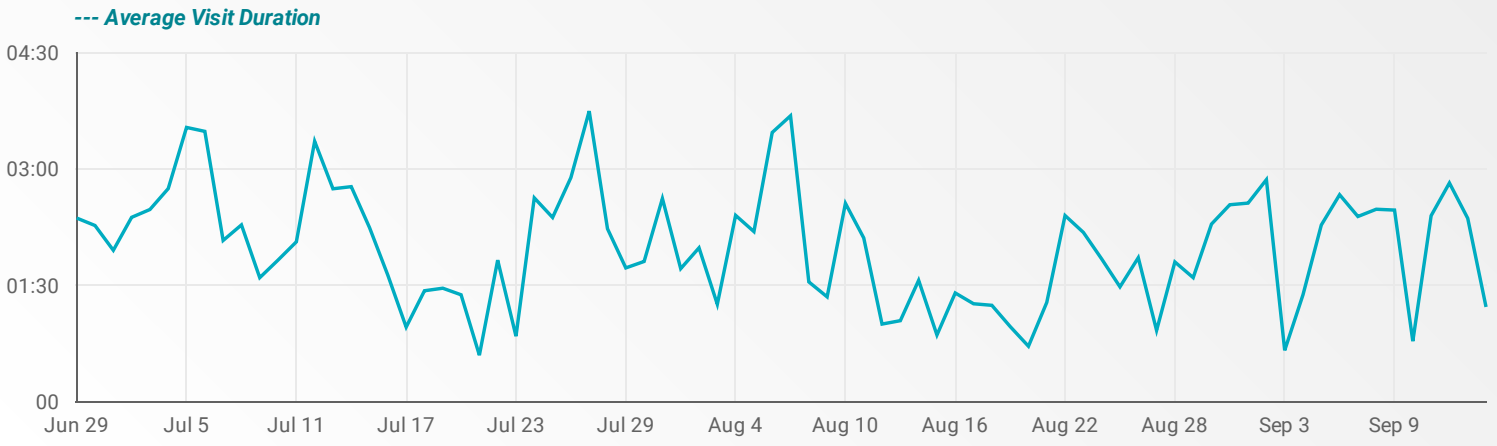

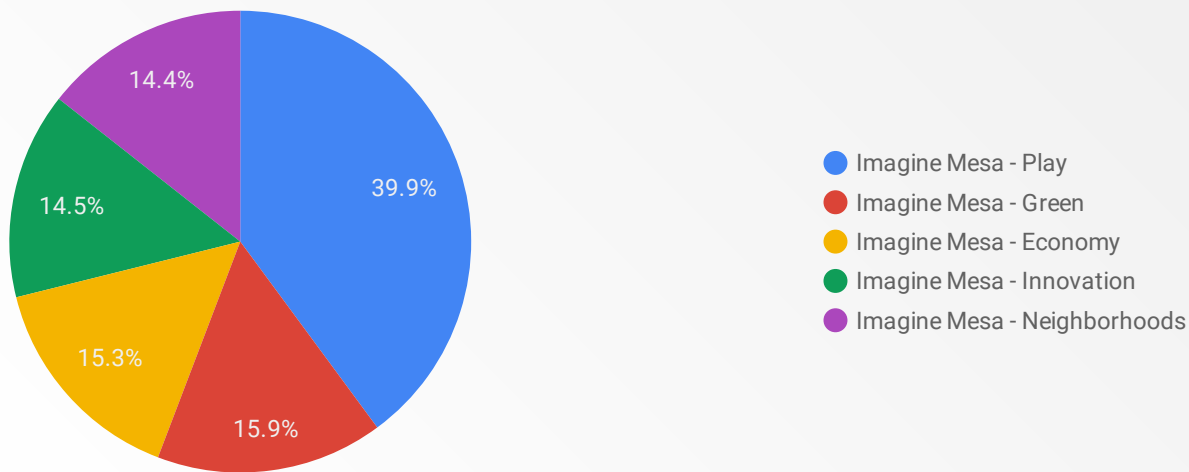
### How long are users staying on the site?

Selected date range vs. previous period



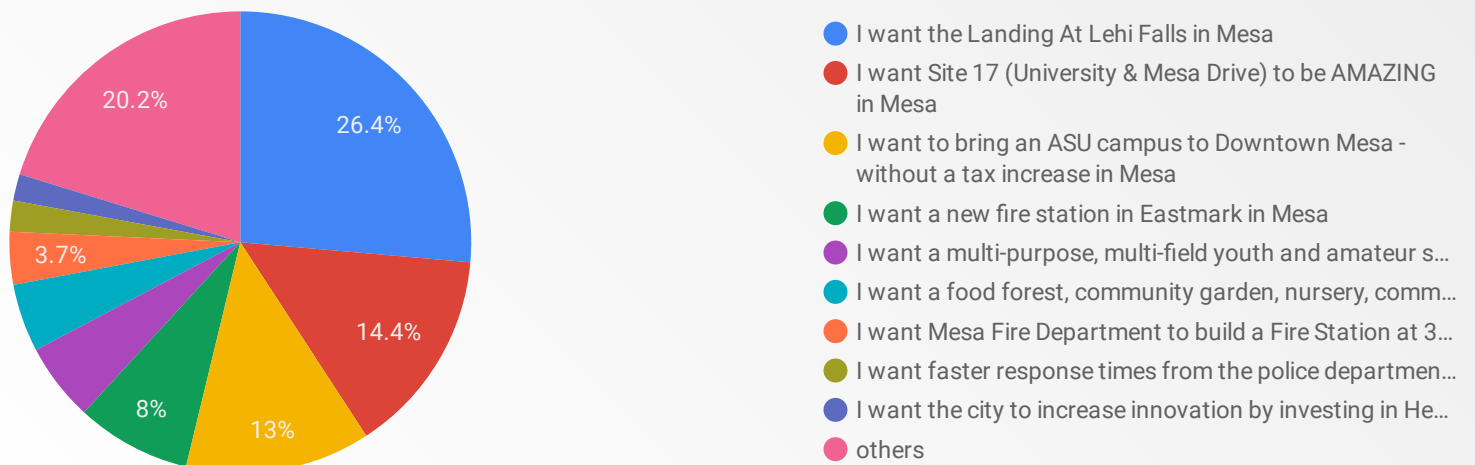
### What Vision Forums are being visited the most?

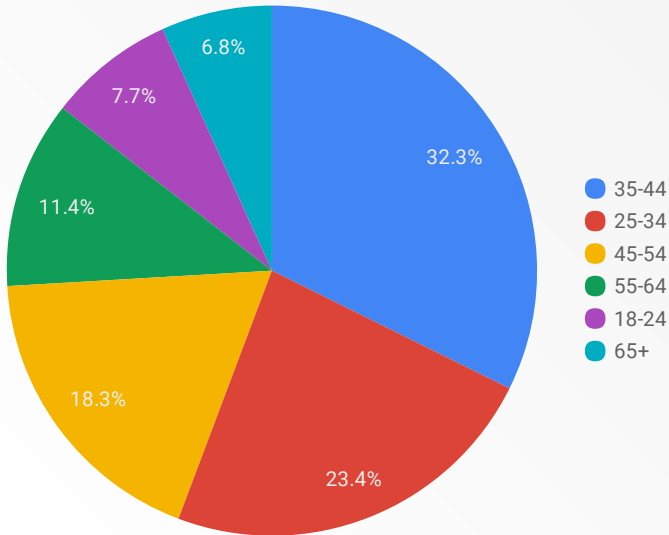
Showing the most viewed ideas over the selected date range





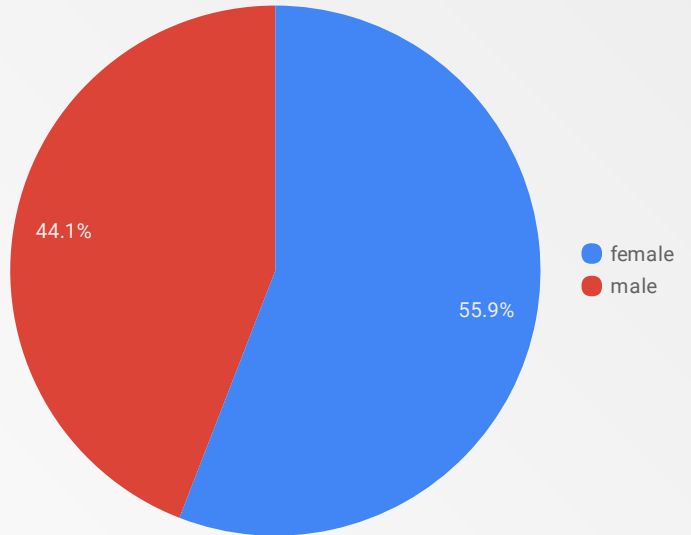
### What age groups do site visitors fall into?

Showing the age distribution of site visitors



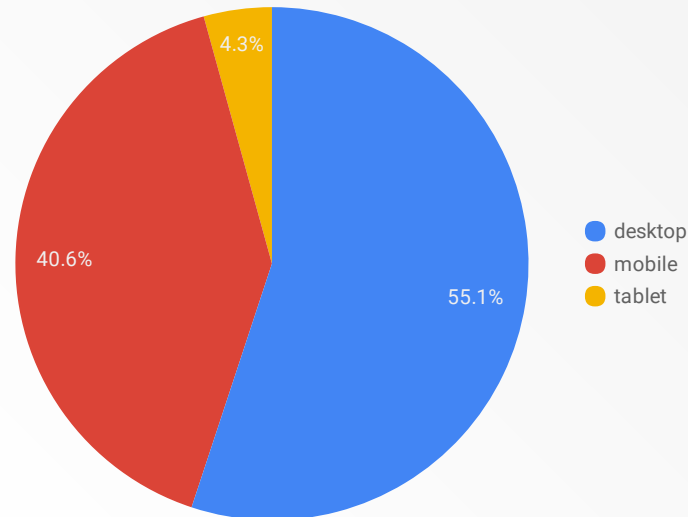
### What gender do site visitors fall into?

Showing the gender distribution of site visitors



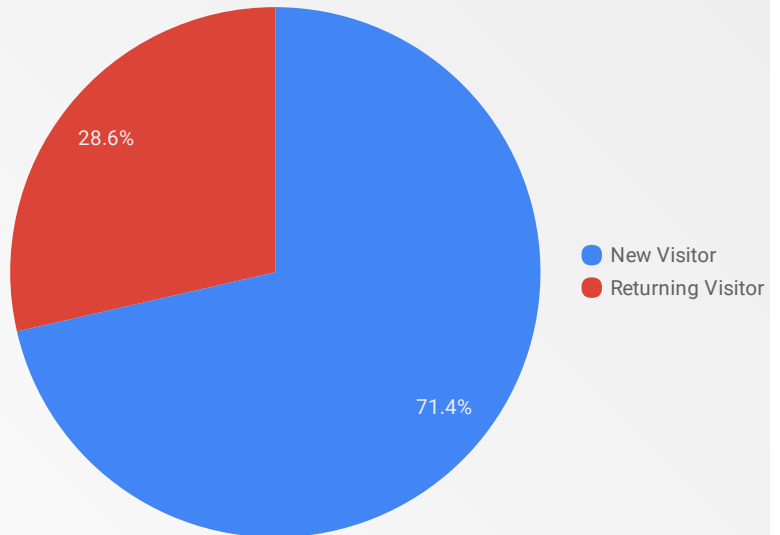
### How are users accessing the site?
