




keforence is made to the information submitted for use in determining the status of the departments and posts under your juriscition for Federal income tax purposes.

In Sureau ruling dated February 26, 1934 it was held that you are entitled to exemption from Federal income tax under the provisions of section 103(8) of the Kevenue Act of 1932 and corresponding provisions of prior revenue acts. Such ruling was affirmed July 8, 1938 under the hevenue Act of 1936 and is applicable under the provisions of section 101(8) of the Kevenue Act of 1938 and the Internal Revenue Code.

Bined upon the evidence presented, it is held that your departments and posts appearing on the lists submitted with an affidavit dated February 27, 1948 or your Estional Adjutant are entitled to exemption from Federal income tax under the provisions of section 101(8) of the Internal Revenue Code and corresponding provisions of prior revenue acts.

Accordingly, your departments and costs appearing on the lists submitted will not be required to file income tax returns unless there is a change in their character, purposes or method of operation. Any such changes should be reported immediately to this Bureau in order that their effect upon the exampt status of the departments and posts under your jurisdiction may be determined.

You should furnish the Bureau annually, on the calendar year basis, lists in quadruplicate showing only the names, numbers and addresses of any new departments and posts which were chartered by you during the calendar year and the names, numbers and addresses of my departments and posts which for any reason have seased to exist. Such annual lists should be accompanied by a statement sworn to by one of your principal officers us to whether the information heretofore submitted by you and on which this ruling is based



#### 2 - The American Legion

is applicable in all respects to the departments and posts appearing on the lists and should be forwarded so as to reach this office not later than February 15 of the following your:

Contributions made to you and your departments and posts are deductible by the denors in arriving at their texable not income in the manner and to the extent provided by section 23(0) and (q) of the internal Rowenie Code, as amended.

However, under section 54(f), as added to the Internal Revenue Gode by section 117 of the Revenue Act of 1945, you and your depertments and posts are required to file annually information reburns on Form 980 (Revised May 1944) with the collector of internal revenue for the respective districts in which located so long as the examption remains in effect. This form may be obtained from the collector and is required to be filed on or before the fifteenth day of the fifth month following the close of the respective annual accounting periods. Your departments may file annually in addition to a separate amount return, a group return on form 690 for two or more of the local posts which are affiliated with such department, Group returns on Form 990 shall be filed in accordance with the regulations promulgated under the income tax chapter of the Internal Revenue Code and the instructions on form 990 and shall be considered the return of each of the local posts included therein.

The collectors of internal revenue for the districts in which you and your departments and posts are located are being advised of this action.

Dear Finance Officer Kent:

In reply to your recent request, The National Organization of The American Legion was granted its exempt status by the Internal Revenue Service in 1934. In February of 1946, we submitted to the central office of the Internal Revenue Service a complete listing of all Departments and Posts extant in the Legion up to and including December 31, 1945. With our submission we requested a group ruling which would extend exemption from the payment of federal income tax for those Departments and Posts designated in our listing.

Each year since 1946 supplemental listings have been transmitted to the Internal Revenue Service for an over-all group ruling covering those Departments and Posts chartered during the previous year. Group rulings have been issued yearly by the Internal Revenue Service covering those Departments and Posts. Since Frank Luke, Jr.-John C. Greenway Post No. 1 was chartered on June 18, 1919, it was included in our original listing. Enclosed is a copy of the original ruling.

Section 101(8) referred to in the exemption letter corresponds to Section 501 (c) (4) of the 1954 Code. The American Legion, its component Departments and Posts, were exempt from the payment of federal income tax under this Section up to and including the year 1972. By virtue of the passage of Public Law 92-418 on August 29, 1972, veterans' organizations were given a separate classification under the Code, Section 501(c)(19). A copy of that ruling is also enclosed.

Also enclosed please find a copy of a letter we received from the Internal Revenue Service dated February 17, 1976, wherein the National Organization, Departments and Posts were instructed to use the number 0925 as their Group Exemption Number (GEN) when filling their Form 990.

In addition, the status of The American Legion and its Departments and Posts may allow acceptance of charitable gifts and bequests. The following might be of assistance to you.

Deductability of Contributions to The American Legion is governed by 26 U.S.C. 170 (c) (3) Internal Revenue Code of 1954, as amended.

Deductibility for bequests is established by 26 U.S.C. Section 2055 (a) (4).

Section 170(c)(3) reads as follows:

"Section 170. Charitable, etc., contributions and

- (a) Allowance of deduction
  - (1) General Rule. There shall be allowed as a deduction any charitable contribution (as defined in sub-section (c) payment of which is made within the taxable year. A charitable contribution shall be allowable as a deduction only if verified under regulations prescribed by the Secretary or his delegate.
  - (c) Charitable contribution defined. For purposes of this section the term 'charitable contribution' means a contribution or gift to or for the use of -
  - (3) A post or organization of war veterans, or an auxiliary unit or society of, or trust or foundation for, any such post or organization -
    - (A) organized in the United States or any of its possessions, and
    - (B) no part of the net earnings of which inures to the benefit of any private shareholder or individual,"

According to the records at The American Legion National Headquarters, your Post EIN is 86-0035253.

Also enclosed is a copy of the Regan v. Taxation with Representation, 461 U.S. 540 (1983).

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#### Liquor Operations Service Agreement



American Legion Post 1, Jeff Frain and Steve Blank desires to engage BTN, LLC for the purpose of providing liquor-related services, operations and staffing from the 2014 UFEST taking place at Quail Run Park in Mesa and BTN, LLC desires to perform those services set within the below Agreement.

- 1. BTN, LLC Agrees to Provide:
- 2.
- a. Management of all liquor inventory, sales, distribution, storage and control
- b. Bartending services for all public areas
- c. Staffing for all of the services
- d. Other support as needed for the bartending services
- e. Supervision and direction of the collection of income from the Liquor Operations
- f. Arrange for the maintenance of complete books of account and records for the Liquor Operations
- g. Displaying of the Liquor License in accordance with the Liquor Laws and the State of
- h. Perform such other tasks as are usual and customary in the operation of an alcoholic beverage procedures, and proper identification process of patrons.
