**Subject:** Purchase of One New Vehicle for the Police Department (**Funded by RICO, Racketeer Influenced Corrupt Organizations**) (Citywide)

## Purpose and Recommendation

Council is requested to approve the purchase of one new vehicle as recommended.

Police and Purchasing recommend authorizing the purchase using the State of Arizona cooperative contract with Midway Chevrolet at \$37,415.07.

## Background / Discussion

This purchase will provide one vehicle for the Police Department. This vehicle will not be part of the department's regular fleet inventory and will give the Police Department the ability to reduce their lease fleet by one.

The State contract was competitively bid, allows cooperative use and meets the City's procurement requirements. Using the cooperative contract provides volume based pricing beneficial to City. For this single vehicle, it is unlikely that competitively bidding will produce better pricing or significant savings than through the cooperative contract.

## Alternatives

Council may choose not to authorize the purchase and new bids will be obtained.

## Fiscal Impact

The total amount of \$37,415.07 is available in the Police operating budget through Racketeer Influenced Corrupt Organizations (RICO) funding. Maintenance for the vehicles will be funded from RICO funds.
