## Review items on the agenda for the May 5, 2014 Regular Council Meeting.

Office of Management and Budget Director Candace Cannistraro addressed the Council and stated that with respect to item 6-e (Modifying rates for wastewater utility services), the ordinance that was published has been modified slightly. BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Mesa, Maricopa County, State of Arizona, as follows:
