BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA,
MARICOPA COUNTY, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Approving the Intergovernmental Agreement between the Arizona Department of Transportation (ADOT) and the City of Mesa identifying the responsibilities of ADOT and the City concerning the construction, subsequent ownership and maintenance of solar lighting and associated equipment for the Rio Salado Multiuse Path. The specific location of the Rio Salado Multiuse Path is depicted on Exhibit A attached hereto.
