Subject: Purchase of Three Replacement Mechanical Street Sweepers for the Transportation Department (Two Vehicles funded by CMAQ – Congestion Mitigation Federal Grant with a local match from the Environmental Compliance Fee, and One Vehicle funded by the Environmental Compliance Fee) **(Citywide)**

Purpose and Recommendation

Council is requested to approve a contract to purchase three Mechanical Street Sweepers as recommended.

Fleet Services, Transportation and Purchasing recommend awarding the contract to lowest priced, responsive and responsible bidder, RWC International, Ltd. at \$757,393.88.

Background / Discussion

This contract is for the purchase of three Mechanical Street Sweepers with high dump capability. The sweepers are being replaced as part of the ongoing City of Mesa vehicle replacement program managed by Fleet Services. These vehicles have met established criteria and will be retired and sold at auction.

Alternatives

Council may choose not to authorize the purchase and new responses will be solicited.

Fiscal Impact

The purchase of two sweepers is funded by the CMAQ – Congestion Mitigation Federal Grant with a local match from Environmental Compliance Fee, and one sweeper is funded by the Environmental Compliance Fee.
