**Subject:** Purchase of Two Replacement Light-Duty Pickup Trucks, for the Engineering

Department (Funded by the Vehicle Replacement Fund) (Citywide)

# **Purpose and Recommendation**

Council is requested to approve the purchase of replacement vehicles, two light-duty extended cab pickup trucks as recommended.

Fleet Services, Engineering and Purchasing recommend authorizing purchase from the contract with Berge Ford (a Mesa business) at \$50,254.06.

# **Background / Discussion**

This purchase will provide two replacement vehicles (2014 Ford 1/2-ton extended cab pickups) to support Engineering operations. The trucks will be used by the Construction Inspections group to inspect Capital Improvement projects.

The replacement vehicles are part of the ongoing City of Mesa vehicle replacement program managed by Fleet Services. The vehicles have met established criteria and will be retired and sold at auction.

These vehicles are additional purchases against a contract (through the City's bid process) originally awarded on July 1, 2014, which provided for additional purchases.

#### **Alternatives**

Council may choose not to authorize the purchase and new responses will be solicited.

## **Fiscal Impact**

The purchase is funded by the Vehicle Replacement Fund.
