# **Purpose and Recommendation**

Council is requested to approve the Term Contract for Class 250 Residential Gas Meters as recommended.

Business Services, Energy Resources and Purchasing recommend awarding the contract to the lowest priced, responsive and responsible bidder, Energy Economics, Inc. at \$252,200.00 annually, based on estimated requirements.

# **Background / Discussion**

This contract will provide Class 250 residential gas meters for the City's natural gas distribution system for the purpose of measuring customer gas usage. The bid quantities are annual estimates based on past experience and anticipated usage. Meters will be ordered as needed throughout the term of the contract by Materials and Supply. Deliveries will be made to the East Mesa Service Center Warehouse.

#### **Alternatives**

Council may choose not to authorize the purchase and new responses will be solicited.

#### **Fiscal Impact**

The annual contract amount is funded by the Warehouse Internal Service Fund.
