Subject: Ratification of the Emergency Purchase of Repairs to JCB Loader as

requested by the Fleet Services Department (Citywide)

Purpose and Recommendation

Council is requested to ratify and approve emergency repairs to a JCB Wheel Loader as recommended.

Fleet Services and Purchasing recommend ratifying the emergency purchase in the amount of \$33,404.29 from Forklift Exchange Inc. dba Flaksa JCB.

Background / Discussion

In July, one of the City's JCB 416 HT Wheel Loaders was involved in a soft rollover. The Rollover Protection System (ROPS) prevented serious injury to the operator but was damaged in the incident.

Staff was unable to locate a similar loader with a 4-in-1 bucket to use while repairs were to be completed. Repairs by the original manufacturer's local dealer, Forklift Exchange, were requested as an emergency during the Council's summer break because the loader is a piece of equipment used during potential monsoon response.

The emergency purchase was approved by the Fleet Services Director and by the City Manager's Office.

Fiscal Impact

The emergency repairs are funded by the Energy Resources Department's operating budget.
