A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER IN TO AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH THE SALT RIVER PIMA-MARICOPA INDIAN COMMUNITY FOR THE RECEIPT AND DISTRIBUTION OF PROPOSITION 202 FUNDS.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1</u>: Arizona's Indian Gaming Compact provides that a Tribe makes twelve percent (12%) of its net annual State contribution to cities, towns or counties for government services that benefit the general public.

<u>Section 2</u>: The Salt River Pima-Maricopa Indian Community wishes to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement with the City of Mesa to receive and distribute \$461,055.00 from its 2014 12% revenues for grants as follows:

- \$ 100,000.00 to **A New Leaf** for support to the construction project of the New Leaf's La Mesita Family Homeless Shelter.
- \$20,000.00 to the **Boy Scouts of America- Grand Canyon Council** for Scouting Outreach Programs of Scouting through Soccer, Juvenile Diversion, Foster Care Mentoring, Afterschool Intervention and New Unit Development to benefit more young men.
- \$146,055.00 to the City of Mesa for the Mesa Fire and Medical Department & Mesa Counts On College, Mesa Fire and Medical Department Immunizations Program for free immunizations services to adults and children in the City of Mesa. Mesa Counts on College- to purchase furnishing to the mesa Counts on College Education Center.
- \$ 40,000.00 to the **Tumbleweed Center for Youth Development** to assist with the overall operating budget of Safe Place and the Open Hands Shelter.
- \$5,000.00 to **Whisper n Thunder Inc.**, to fund ATHENA leadership programs.
- \$150,000.00to the **United Food Bank** for the funding of Emergency & Supplemental Food program.

<u>Section 3</u>: The City Council supports these grants and authorizes the City Manager to enter into the proposed Intergovernmental Agreement with the Salt River Pima-Maricopa Indian Community for the receipt and distribution of this funding.
