- Subject: Purchase of One Replacement Medium-Duty Cab and Chassis Service Body Vehicle for the Transportation Department (Funded by the Vehicle Replacement Fund) (Citywide)

Purpose and Recommendation

Council is requested to approve the purchase of one replacement medium-duty utility truck as recommended.

Fleet Services, Transportation and Purchasing recommend authorizing purchase from the State of Arizona cooperative contract with, PFVT Motors Inc., at \$25,094.53.

Background / Discussion

This purchase will provide a 2015 Ford F-350 (1-ton), 4X2 regular cab and chassis, 60^e cab to axle utility truck for use by the Transportation Department.

The vehicle being replaced has been damaged beyond repair. A replacement vehicle is needed as soon as possible. Using the State cooperative contract will allow timely replacement compared to issuing a bid. Using the State contract is beneficial to the City due to the discounted pricing received for the State's high volume of vehicle purchases.

Alternatives

Council may choose not to authorize the purchase and new responses will be solicited.

Fiscal Impact

This purchase is funded by the Vehicle Replacement Fund.
