Subject: Purchase of Fleet Additions of Two Light-Duty Pickup Trucks for the

Development and Sustainability Department (Citywide)

Purpose and Recommendation

Council is requested to approve a contract to purchase two light-duty extended cab pickup trucks as additions to the fleet as recommended.

Fleet Services, Development and Sustainability and Purchasing recommend purchase from the contract with Berge Ford (a Mesa business) at \$50,254.06.

Background / Discussion

The Development and Sustainability Department received approval for two Code Officers as 2014/15 mid-year additions. The additional positions were necessary to improve response time to Mesa residents' complaints about blight and other influences that cause deteriorating conditions, unattractive neighborhoods, and potential loss of property value. The two additional positions bring the total code compliance work force to nine code officers and one supervisor responding to 10,100 complaints, covering 133 square miles.

These vehicles are additional purchases against a contract (through the City's bid process) originally awarded on July 1, 2014, which provided for additional purchases.

Alternatives

Council may choose not to authorize the purchase and new responses will be solicited.

Fiscal Impact

The total amount is funded by Fleet Services Department budget.
