# **Purpose and Recommendation**

Council is requested to approve the Re-Award Purchase of One Replacement Medium-Duty Cab and Chassis Vehicle equipped with a Telescopic Crane as recommended.

Fleet Services, Water Resources and Purchasing recommend awarding the contract to the second lowest, responsive and responsible bidder, Berge Ford (a Mesa business) at \$47.901.24.

# **Background / Discussion**

On February 9, 2015, Council awarded a contract for this purchase to Peoria Ford (PFVT) and the vendor was notified of the City's intent to award. PFVT could not hold their pricing 180 days as specified in the contract, this violation of the contract was apparently driven by Ford's new pricing update. Berge Ford is willing to hold their pricing for 180 days. The additional cost is \$3,338.80.

This purchase will provide one replacement vehicle, a 2015 Ford 1-ton, 4X2 cab chassis equipped with a 9' service body and telescopic crane, to support Wastewater Utility's daily operations. The replacement vehicle is part of the ongoing City of Mesa vehicle replacement program managed by Fleet Services. The vehicle has met established criteria and will be retired and sold at auction.

Purchasing and Fleet Services agreed to cancel the purchase order with PFVT, and reaward the purchase to the second lowest bidder, Berge Ford.

#### **Alternatives**

Council may choose not to authorize the purchase and new responses will be solicited.

#### **Fiscal Impact**

This purchase is funded by the Utility Replacement Extension and Renewal Fund.
