Larry, Transportation is ok with the gate concept they are proposing on 9<sup>th</sup> Street. Need to be certain that gates are not in the right-of-way, gates will not open onto the right-of-way, that both gates can be activated as exits and that any modifications to the gates or operation of the gates will need to be reviewed and approved by Transportation prior to any changes being made. As I understand it, the east gate will be a resident only entrance gate (and an all use exit gate) using a signal/clicker device that the complex will provide to the resident. The east gate will be an exit only gate. However, both gates will be accessible by Fire using an optics controlled gate opener for emergencies. The Rio Salado driveway will not be gated (if there is a desire to gate the Rio Salado driveway, it will need to meet the intent of the M-42.1 driveway of the City Specifications). Please let me know if there are any questions.
