Subject: Purchase of Two Replacement Sports Utility Vehicles for the Police Department **(Funded by the Vehicle Replacement Fund) (Citywide)**

Purpose and Recommendation

Council is requested to approve the contract for the purchase of two replacement Sports Utility Vehicles (SUVs) as recommended.

The Fleet Services and Police Departments, and Purchasing recommend awarding the contract to the lowest, responsive and responsible bidder, Midway Chevrolet at \$78,562.59.

Background / Discussion

This purchase will provide two, 2016 Chevrolet Tahoe SUV's, Non-Pursuit, 2-Wheel Drive, 4-Door vehicles to support Police Department operations. This purchase is part of the ongoing City of Mesa vehicle replacement program managed by Fleet Services. The vehicles being replaced have met established criteria and will be retired and sold at auction.

Alternatives

Council may choose not to authorize the purchase and new bids will be obtained.
