**Subject:** Purchase of Two-Way Digital Radios and Accessories for the Environmental

Management and Sustainability Department (Citywide)

#### **Purpose and Recommendation**

Council is requested to authorize the Purchase of Two-Way Digital Radios and Accessories as recommended.

The Environmental Management and Sustainability, and Communications Departments, and Purchasing recommend authorizing the purchase using the State of Arizona cooperative contract with B&B Selectcom, Inc. at \$84,180.71, based on estimated requirements.

### **Background / Discussion**

This purchase will provide mobile and portable dispatch radios including accessories for the Environmental Management and Sustainability Department. The radios are needed for staff to communicate on work projects, in the field, and during emergency events each day.

In July 2015, the Transportation Department switched from using the TOPAZ radio network for their wireless communications to these two-way radios that operate on the existing Mesa Public Schools (MPS) radio system. Council approved an Intergovernmental Agreement with MPS to partner with and expand MPS's system use to accommodate Mesa non-Public Safety City Departments. The radios for this MPS network and purchase are approximately 1/6th the cost of the equivalent radios for the TOPAZ radio network.

In addition, the MPS network is a commercial-grade system which is anticipated to cost less to maintain than the TOPAZ voice radio network. This is expected to result in an estimated annual cost savings of \$79,000.00 per year for the Environmental Management and Sustainability Department.

The Environmental Management and Sustainability Department worked with Communications on identifying the radios needed, and obtained quotes from several State contracted vendors. The vendor with the lowest quote is being recommended for award.

#### **Alternatives**

Council may choose not to authorize the purchase and bids will be obtained.

#### **Fiscal Impact**

The purchase is funded by the Environmental Management and Sustainability Department budget. As noted in the Background / Discussion section, the payback on this purchase for the Environmental Management and Sustainability Department is slightly over a year.
