The Audit, Finance & Enterprise Committee of the City of Mesa met in the lower level meeting room of the Council Chambers, 57 East 1st Street, on April 14, 2016, at 9:43 a.m.

1. Items from citizens present.

There were no items from citizens present.

2-a. Hear a presentation, discuss and provide a recommendation on the proposed fees and charges for various departments.

Office of Management and Budget Director Candace Cannistraro stated that she would provide a brief overview of the proposed fees and charges for various departments. She explained that the respective department directors were present in the audience and available to respond to any questions the Committee might have.

Ms. Cannistraro displayed a PowerPoint presentation (See Attachment 1) and reported that this year, limited changes are proposed to the FY 2016/17 Schedule of Fees and Charges. She offered a short synopsis of the changes submitted by the following departments:

- 1. Arts and Culture Several language clarifications to the Fees & Charges Schedule. (See Attachment 2) No financial impact.
- Business Services Implement a new Technology Improvement Fee (\$2.00 per Specialty Business License). The funds would be allocated to OpenCounter, a self-service module that would walk customers through a series of questions to determine which licenses or permits they need to obtain from the City. The fee would be assessed to the person using this service.

3. Development Services – Initiate a new \$180 per dwelling unit Interior Rental Inspection Repair Verification Fee in order to cover the cost of inspecting the improvements made to unsafe residential structures. The fee would be based on the inspector's time and equipment usage. Currently, the department does not charge for the follow-up inspection, which is inconsistent with the inspection charges for all other types of building permits. Financial impact - \$20,700.

Remove various fees no longer needed as it relates to oversized drawings; sign insignia identification tag; and the demolition of pools.

Update Solid Waste Residential Development Fee for Multi-Family Dwellings. The revised language would exclude apartments of five or more units in accordance with recent changes in state law. Financial impact - \$62,000.

4. Municipal Court – Increase the Preparation of Transcript Fee from \$3.65 per page to \$4.15 per page. The fee, which is based on a contract with the vendor, is paid by the defendants. No financial impact.

Update the Mesa City Code in order to clarify the Court Sustainability Fee.

5. Transportation Department – Change the fee structure with respect to the Temporary Traffic Control (TTC) Fee from "time periods" to "number of days." (For example, from 16 to 30 days for a set rate to 20 days at a daily charge.) Financial impact - \$184,100.

Add Traffic Control Plan Review Fee for third and subsequent reviews.

Add Traffic Barricading Coordinator.

It was moved by Committeemember Finter, seconded by Committeemember Thompson, that staff's recommendations be forwarded on to the full Council for discussion and consideration.

Chairman Glover declared the motion carried unanimously.

Chairman Glover thanked Ms. Cannistraro for the presentation.

Adjournment.
