Subject:	Three-Year Term Contract for Electric Utility Distribution Transformers for the Materials and Supply Warehouse (for the Energy Resources Department) <b>(Citywide)</b>

#### **Purpose and Recommendation**

Council is requested to approve the Term Contract for Electric Utility Distribution Transformers as recommended.

The Business Services, and Energy Resources Departments, and Purchasing recommend awarding the contract to Central Maloney, Inc.; and Border States Electric; cumulatively not to exceed \$1,083,235.00 annually, based on estimated requirements.

#### **Background / Discussion**

This contract will provide electric utility distribution transformers as specified (O-1610 -Single Phase Conventional Transformer, U-1610 - Single Phase Pad Mounted Transformer and U-1630 – Two and Three Phase Pad Mounted Transformer) to provide electric power delivery to the City's electric customers. These transformers are required for new/revised customer service installations and equipment replacement installations. Materials and Supply places orders and maintains stock inventory as needed.

It is essential that Energy Resources have an adequate supply of distribution transformers in warehouse stock to handle both new construction and emergency replacement needs.

Specification U-1640 – Three Phase Submersible Transformer will not be awarded.

#### Alternatives

Council may choose not to authorize the purchase and new bids will be obtained.

#### **Fiscal Impact**

The annual contract amount is available in the Materials and Supply operating budget through the Warehouse Internal Service Fund.
