Subject: Purchase of Information Technology Related Products and Services for the

New Mesa Fire and Medical Regional Dispatch Center and Emergency Operations Center (Funded by 2013 Public Safety Bonds) (District 3)

Purpose and Recommendation

Council is requested to approve the Purchase of Products and Services to meet the information technology, communications, and Maricopa Regional 911 needs of the new Mesa Regional Dispatch and Regional Emergency Operations Center.

The Information Technology, Communications, Fire & Medical Departments, and Purchasing recommend authorizing purchases using several cooperative contracts, sole source, active City contracts, and competitive quotes.

The recommended total for the products and services is \$1,090,195.73. In addition to this total, Council is requested to approve an additional \$200,000.00 in contingency funds for incidental items that may be needed during the installation and implementation of the technology equipment. The combined total amount is \$1,290,195.73.

Background / Discussion

On November 5, 2013, Mesa voters approved a Public Safety Bond Program that included a new Fire and Medical Dispatch Communications Center. The existing Fire and Medical dispatch center is co-located with the Police Department dispatch center in the Communications building on E. 6th Place. Much of the key radio communication equipment for the City is also located within this facility. The current dispatch center does not provide redundancy and has reached capacity.

On November 23, 2015, Council directed staff to purchase the property located at 708 W. Baseline Road in order to use one of the buildings for the new Regional Dispatch Center and Regional Emergency Operations Center. The new facility will create additional dispatch space for the Fire and Medical Department and back-up dispatch capability for the Police Department as well as add communications redundancy for the City in the event that the current facility or communications system were to experience a failure. This new location will allow for expansion of existing dispatch capability, should call volumes increase in future years.

This purchase will provide for the configuration and installation of IT, Maricopa 911 Dispatch, and communications equipment required by Fire & Medical to operate both regional facilities.

Alternatives

Council may choose not to authorize purchase.

Fiscal Impact

This purchase is funded by authorized 2013 Public Safety Bonds (Capital Improvement Program Project CP0340).
