Purpose and Recommendation

The purpose of this report is to provide information to the Council concerning the results of the bids received for the Arterial Reconstruction Project on University Drive from 22nd Place to Val Vista Drive. Staff recommends that Council award this project to the lowest responsible bidder, Combs Construction Company Inc., in the amount of \$1,823,120.00.

Background

The asphalt pavement on University Drive from 22nd Place to Val Vista Drive is nearing the end of its life cycle and is in need of replacement.

Discussion

This project replaces deteriorated asphalt pavement with new surface and base courses of polymer modified asphalt pavement over the existing aggregate base course (ABC). Once underway the project is anticipated to last no more than two (2) months.

Alternatives

An alternative to this project would be to not construct these improvements. This would result in continued roadway deterioration with potentially more costly repairs in the future.

Fiscal Impact

The recommended total award amount for this project is \$2,005,432.00, based on the lowest responsible bidder of \$1,823,120.00, plus an additional \$182,312.00 (10% allowance for change orders). Funding is available in 2013 Authorized Street Bonds.
