7. ALL TOP SOIL MIXTURE FOR PLANTS SHALL BE FREE OF GRASS AND NOXIOUS WEEDS. SEE SECTION 795

8. PLANT SOIL MIXTURE SHALL CONSIST OF 3 1/2-PARTS NATURAL FERTILE, FRIABLE SOIL AND ONE PART HUMUS BY VOLUME, THOROUGHLY MIXED PRIOR TO BACKFILLING IN PITS. BACKFILLING SHALL BE IN 6-INCH

ALL PLANT MATERIAL SHALL CONFORM TO GRADING, TYPE, ETC..., AS SET FORTH IN THE AMERICAN ASSOCIATION OF NURSERYMEN AND BY THE ARIZONA NURSERY ASSOCIATION RECOMMENDED TREE SPECIFICATIONS. 10.
