Subject:	Purchase of Two Additional Sports Utility Vehicles for the Police Department (Funded by the Capital – General Fund) (Citywide)

## **Purpose and Recommendation**

Council is requested to approve the purchase of two additional Sports Utility Vehicles (SUVs) as recommended.

The Fleet Services and Police Departments, and Purchasing recommend authorizing the purchase using the State of Arizona cooperative contract with Midway Chevrolet at \$81,258.32.

## **Background / Discussion**

This purchase will provide two 2016 Police Patrol SUVs - Chevrolet Tahoe, 2-Wheel Drive, 4-Door vehicles. Both SUV units will be utilized to support six of the twelve new Police positions that Council approved this past year.

In particular, these two vehicles will add Officer back up support for the Light Rail Bike Patrol Officers to assist in the transport of suspects detained by the Light Rail Bike Patrol Officers. These vehicles will also and used in conjunction with backup and support for the Crisis Response Team Officers.

#### Alternatives

Council may choose not to authorize the purchase and new responses will be solicited.

#### **Fiscal Impact**

This purchase is funded by the Capital General Fund budget.
