A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER IN TO AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH THE TOHONO O'ODHAM NATION FOR THE RECEIPT AND DISTRIBUTION OF PROPOSITION 202 FUNDS.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1</u>: Arizona's Indian Gaming Compact provides that an Indian Tribe make twelve percent (12%) of its net annual State contribution to cities, towns or counties for government services that benefit the general public. Private, not-for-profit organizations wishing to access Indian Gaming Funds ("Gaming Funds") to provide public benefits must secure sponsorship from a city, town or county before making application. This sponsorship must be expressed in a resolution passed by the local government sponsor.

<u>Section 2</u>: The Tohono O'odham Nation wishes the City of Mesa to receive and distribute \$12,500.00 from its 2016 12% revenues for grants as follows:

\$12,500.00 to Gene Lewis Boxing Club.

<u>Section 3</u>: The City Council supports these grants and authorizes the City Manager, or his designee, to accept and administer the 2016 awarded Gila River Indian Community Proposition 202 funding.
