**A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA,
MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING
THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A MASTER AGREEMENT
FOR WIRELESS ANTENNA ON EXISTING STRUCTURE IN THE
RIGHT OF WAY WITH COX COMMUNICATIONS ARIZONA, LLC.**

WHEREAS, City is authorized to regulate its streets, alleys, public utility easements, utility easements, and other easements; to grant, deny, amend and terminate licenses for and otherwise regulate the installation, operation and maintenance of such facilities within the City's boundaries pursuant to the Mesa City Charter, the Mesa City Code, Title 9, and by virtue of federal (47 U.S.C. § 253) and state statutes (including, but not limited to A.R.S. §§ 9-240, 9-276, 9-581, 9-582, and 9-583), by the City's police powers, its authority over public rights-of-way, and its other governmental powers and authority; and

WHEREAS, Cox Communications Arizona, LLC desires the ability to be able to install, operate, maintain and repair wireless antennae and other associated communications facilities on City-owned light poles and within the public streets, rights-of-way, and easements of the City;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, AS FOLLOWS:

The Master Agreement for Wireless Antenna On Existing Structure In The Right Of Way, between the City of Mesa and Cox Communications Arizona, LLC ("Master Agreement") is hereby approved.

The Council of the City of Mesa hereby authorizes City Manager Christopher J. Brady, or his designated representative, to enter into the Master Agreement and execute any other documents needed to implement the Master Agreement on behalf of the City of Mesa, and authorizes the City Clerk to attest to the signature of the City Manager thereon.
