Subject:	Purchase of Eight Replacement Ford Interceptor SUVs for the Police Department (Funded by the Vehicle Replacement Fund) (Citywide)

Purpose and Recommendation

Council is requested to approve the purchase of eight Sport Utility Vehicles (SUVs) as recommended.

The Fleet Services and Police Departments, and Purchasing recommend authorizing purchase from the contract with PFVT Motors, Inc., dba Peoria Ford at \$270,359.84.

Background / Discussion

This purchase will provide eight, 2017 Ford Interceptor SUVs (Option K8A), all-wheel drive, 4-door, Police Patrol with full cage to support Police Operations. This purchase is part of the ongoing City of Mesa vehicle replacement program managed by Fleet Services. The vehicles being replaced have met established criteria and will be either traded, auctioned, sold, or deployed to special uses.

The eight vehicles are additional purchases from a contract Council awarded on December 8, 2015 that allows additional purchases.

Alternatives

Council may choose not to authorize the purchase and new bids will be obtained.

Fiscal Impact

This purchase is funded by the Vehicle Replacement Fund.
