for the Police Department (Grant Funded by AZ Department of Homeland

Security) (Citywide)

# **Purpose and Recommendation**

Council is requested to approve the Purchase of Three Light Duty Pickup Trucks as recommended.

The Fleet Services and Police Departments, and Purchasing recommend authorizing purchase from the contract with Berge Ford (a Mesa business) at \$117,749.75.

# **Background / Discussion**

The two replacement vehicles are being replaced as part of the ongoing City of Mesa vehicle replacement program managed by Fleet Services. Both vehicles have met established criteria and will be either traded, auctioned, sold, or deployed to special uses. The three vehicles will be used to support Police operations.

The proposed vehicles are additional purchases from a contract Council awarded on January 11, 2016 that allows additional purchases.

# **Alternatives**

Council may choose not to authorize the purchase and new responses will be solicited.

This purchase is funded by AZ Department of Homeland Security Grant Funds.
