**Subject**: Purchase of Replacement IT Security Management Software for the

Information Technology Department (Citywide)

## **Purpose and Recommendation**

Council is requested to approve the Purchase of IT Security Management Software to replace the existing end-of-life Reverse Proxy hardware/software solution.

The Information Technology Department and Purchasing recommend authorizing the purchase from the Maricopa County cooperative contract and lowest quoted vendor, SHI at \$81,658.58.

## **Background / Discussion**

IT Security Management prevents any direct access to our critical servers by outside threats.

This replacement purchase is critical and recommended for these reasons:

- The current platform is on extended support with its manufacturer. It has not received new functionality to protect against modern internet threats for several years.
- The current platform is running on aging server hardware that has reached its planned retirement date.
- The intrusion detection signatures and threat updates on the current platform are outdated.

This purchase will include: software, support, professional services and training for staff. No hardware is required for this purchase as the City will leverage existing virtual server capacity.

The Information Technology Department obtained four quotes (SHI, CenturyLink, Insight and CDW-G) from contracted vendors. The City believes that issuing a formal bid would not result in any lower pricing, and could possibly cause the City to lose the deep discounts currently being provided SHI under the County contract. The lowest quoted response, SHI is being recommended for award.

#### **Alternatives**

Council may choose not to authorize the purchase and new quotes will be solicited.

## **Fiscal Impact**

This purchase is funded by the Information Technology Department through the Lifecycle Program (Infrastructure) FY 2016/17 budget.
