Subject: Purchase of One Replacement Sports Utility Vehicle for the Police Department
(Funded by the Vehicle Replacement Fund) **(Citywide)**

Purpose and Recommendation

Council is requested to approve the purchase of one Sports Utility Vehicle (SUV) as recommended.

The Fleet Services and Police Departments, and Purchasing recommend authorizing purchase from the contract with Midway Chevrolet at \$37,727.36.

Background / Discussion

This purchase will provide one Chevrolet Tahoe, Police Patrol K9 SUV, a replacement for a vehicle that was damaged beyond repair, to support Police Operations.

This vehicle is an additional purchase from a contract Council awarded on February 6, 2017 that allows additional purchases.

Alternatives

Council may choose not to authorize the purchase and new responses will be solicited.

This purchase is funded by the Vehicle Replacement Fund.
