**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
MESA, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA,
EXTINGUISHING TWO PUBLIC UTILITIES AND
FACILITIES EASEMENTS AND A 20-FOOT PUBLIC
UTILITIES EASEMENT LOCATED AT 3110 NORTH
GREENFIELD ROAD.**

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that two Public Utilities and Facilities Easements granted in documents 2007-0998228 and 2007-0998229 of the records of Maricopa County, Arizona located at 3110 North Greenfield Road as hereafter described, are no longer needed.

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that a 20-foot Public Utilities Easement granted in document 2007-0902086 of the records of Maricopa County, Arizona located at 3110 North Greenfield Road as hereafter described, is no longer needed.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: All rights of the City of Mesa in and to the following described Public Utilities and Facilities Easements are extinguished:

Those certain Public Utilities and Facilities Easements as described in documents 2007-0998228 and 2007-0998229, of the records of Maricopa County, Arizona located within Lots 21, 22, and 23 according to the Final Plat for Dover Industrial Park – Unit Two- Amended, recorded in Book 540 of Maps, Page 10, records of Maricopa County, Arizona, and situated in the Southeast quarter of Section 33, Township 2 North, Range 6 East, of the Gila and Salt River Base and Meridian, Maricopa County, Arizona.

Section 2: All rights of the City of Mesa in and to the following described 20-foot Public Utilities Easement are extinguished:

That certain Public Utilities Easement as described in document 2007-0902086, of the records of Maricopa County, Arizona located within Lots 21, 22, and 23 according to the Final Plat for Dover Industrial Park – Unit Two- Amended, recorded in Book 540 of Maps, Page 10, records of Maricopa County, Arizona, and

situated in the Southeast quarter of Section 33, Township 2 North,
Range 6 East, of the Gila and Salt River Base and Meridian,
Maricopa County, Arizona.
