A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR HIS DESIGNEE TO ENTER INTO A SUBGRANTEE AGREEMENT WITH THE ARIZONA DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY TO RECEIVE UP TO \$240,000 IN GRANT FUNDS FOR EQUIPMENT, TRAINING, AND PLANNING FOR THE MESA FIRE AND MEDICAL DEPARTMENT'S URBAN AREA SECURITY INITIATIVE RAPID RESPONSE TEAM.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, MARICOPA COUNTY, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Authorizing and directing the City Manager, or his designee, to enter into a subgrantee agreement with the Arizona Department of Homeland Security, and any related amendments or supplements thereto, to accept up to \$240,000 in grant funds for equipment, training, and disaster planning to sustain the Mesa Fire and Medical Department's Urban Area Security Initiative Rapid Response Team.

<u>Section 2</u>: Approval by the City Attorney or designee and signature by the City Manager or designee of the Intergovernmental Agreement, and any related amendments or supplements thereto, shall constitute conclusive evidence of this City Council's approval thereof.
