A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR HIS DESIGNEE TO ENTER INTO A GRANT AWARD WITH THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE, OFFICE OF JUSTICE PROGRAMS, TO ACCEPT \$150,000 IN GRANT FUNDS FROM THE NATIONAL INSTITUTE OF JUSTICE FOR OVERTIME AND EQUIPMENT FOR DNA BACKLOG REDUCTION FOR THE POLICE DEPARTMENT'S FORENSIC SERVICES DIVISION.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA,
MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Authoring and directing the City Manager, or his designee, to enter into a Grant Award, and any related amendments or supplements thereto, with the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs to accept \$150,000 in grant funds from the National Institute of Justice for overtime and equipment for DNA backlog reduction for the Police Department's Forensic Services Division.

Section 2: Approval by the City Attorney or designee and signature by the City Manager or designee of the Grant Award, and any related amendments or supplements thereto, shall constitute conclusive evidence of this City Council's approval thereof.
