A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR HIS DESIGNEE TO ENTER INTO A SUBRECIPIENT AGREEMENT WITH THE ARIZONA DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY TO ACCEPT \$200,000 IN GRANT FUNDS FOR EQUIPMENT AND TRAINING TO SUPPORT AND SUSTAIN THE POLICE DEPARTMENT'S RAPID RESPONSE TASK FORCE.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Authorizing and directing the City Manager, or his designee, to enter into a Subrecipient Agreement, and any related amendments or supplements thereto, with the Arizona Department of Homeland Security, to accept \$200,000 in grant funds for equipment and training to support and sustain the Police Department's Rapid Response Task Force.

<u>Section 2</u>: Approval by the City Attorney or designee and signature by the City Manager or designee of the Subrecipient Agreement, and any related amendments or supplements thereto, shall constitute conclusive evidence of this City Council's approval thereof.
