Subject: One-Year Renewal to the Term Contract for Traffic Signal Control Cabinets

for the Materials and Supply Warehouse (for the Transportation Department)

(Citywide)

Recommendation

Council is requested to approve the contract renewal as recommended.

The Business Services Department and Purchasing recommend authorizing the renewal with Sierra Transportation & Technologies, LLC; and Econolite; cumulatively not to exceed \$280,000.00 annually, based on estimated usage.

Background

This contract provides traffic signal cabinets to maintain and replace existing equipment in the field as well as supply new cabinets for traffic signals constructed by the Transportation Department. Spare control cabinet components will be used to replace existing units that may not be cost effective to repair and to update others that may have exceeded their useful life.

Sierra Transportation & Technologies offered to renew with a pricing increase by approximately 1.8% for the traffic signal controller per the Producer Price Index. Econolite offered to renew maintaining last year's pricing. The City has been satisfied with each vendor's performance. This contract continues to be advantageous to the City and it is in the City's best interest to renew the contract.
