Dennis Newburn provided an overview of the FY 2018/19 application process. A total of 64 applications were submitted this year: 1 for HOME, 32 for Human Services, 5 for Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG), and 25 for Community Development Block Grant (CDBG). The application presentations were split into two groups, for two nights of presentations. As part of the application, each agency was asked to submit a 3-minute video explaining why they were applying. Six minutes were scheduled for each application presentation: 3 minutes for the video to be shown, and 3 minutes for questions. Questions from the HCDAB members were answered by Staff and Agency Representatives, who were invited to attend this meeting. Board members were asked to score each presentation for each of the agency as they were presented.

Upon the conclusion of the videos/presentations, Kris Woolley thanked the Staff for their hard work, and thanked those in the audience for attending. Board members then submitted their score sheets to Deanna Grogan.
