Recommendation

Council is requested to approve the emergency purchase as recommended.

The Fire and Medical Department and Purchasing recommend ratifying the purchase from the lowest quoted vendor, Fire Training Structures, LLC at \$209,806.86.

Background / Discussion

This purchase provides a standard 3-stack live fire and confined space USAR training facility that complies with NFPA training standards. This modular burn system will provide our crews the ability to participate in required live burn training.

This purchase is required because of the current delay in completing a new burn building and the associated costs of using an option to train our members at a different facility.

On 5/1/2018, the emergency purchase was approved by the City Manager's office as provided as provided in the City Code.
