The Public Safety Committee of the City of Mesa met in the lower level meeting room of the Council Chambers, 57 East 1st Street, on May 10, 2018 at 10:29 a.m.

1. Items from citizens present.

There were no items from citizens present.

2-a. Hear a presentation and discuss an update on the City's efforts to combat human exploitation and trafficking.

Commander Dan Butler introduced Assistant Chief Sharon Burlingame and Sergeant Nicholas Lien, who displayed a PowerPoint presentation. **(See Attachment 1)** He defined human trafficking and explained the role the Mesa Police Department Human Exploitation and Trafficking Squad (HEat) plays in combating the issue in the community.

Commander Butler identified the non-profit organizations that partner with the HEat unit. He stated the Hickey Family Foundation (HFF) plays a vital role in the success of the HEat unit and explained the HFF contributed \$300,000 to support the team's operations. He added the staff reports back to the HFF on how the funds are being utilized and the results of their efforts. He stated the Operation Underground Railroad organization is also a significant contributor to the HEat unit and recently facilitated the purchase of a new computer forensic vehicle and earmarked \$230,000 for the equipment that will be placed in the new vehicle. He commented that the vehicle will be used to help with human trafficking and child pornography cases. He reported the Valley Against Sex Trafficking organization facilitated a tuition grant for advanced training for one of the detectives within the HEat unit. (See Page 3 of Attachment 1)

In response to a question posed by Committeemember Thompson, Commander Butler advised cases are prioritized and some cases are not worked when members of the HEat Unit are out sick or on vacation and this is due to the limited staffing and resources the Mesa Police Department (MPD) is experiencing.

In response to a question posed by Committeemember Thompson, Assistant Chief Burlingame stated officers that are placed on light duty will assist the HEat unit. She added this transition can be difficult at times due to the amount of training needed to be a vital contributor to the team and some officers are only on light duty for a limited time.

Commander Butler commented that an ASU student that is interested in law enforcement will be interning this summer with the MPD and assisting the HEat unit with investigations.

In response to a question posed by Committeemember Freeman, Assistant City Manager John Pombier commented that additional officers are needed on patrol, therefore some specialty divisions are understaffed.

Committeemember Thompson expressed his passion to eliminate sex trafficking in the City. He recognized the topic is uncomfortable to discuss, however it is occurring in the community and needs to be talked about. He stated the opinion that sex trafficking could be minimized if the HEat unit was properly staffed and he hopes additional officers will be added to the team in the future.

Commander Butler advised the HEat Unit is currently planning a demand operation and a regional operation with the Gilbert Police Department, Chandler Police Department, and Tempe Police Department. He added both are significant operations that will be funded by the community partners and entails the use of many resources. He stated the goal is to collaborate efforts with neighboring police departments in the future to make a greater impact.

In response to a question posed by Committeemember Freeman, Commander Butler reported there are approximately 118 licensed massage businesses on file with the City and 40 of those establishments are listed on the "Rub Maps" website that provide prostitution through massage businesses (**See Attachment 2**). He advised in 2008 a task force was created to specifically investigate massage parlors, however that task force no longer operates due to limited staff available.

In response to a question posed by Committeemember Freeman, Assistant Chief Burlingame advised the massage ordinance was recently updated and is comparable to the ordinance in Scottsdale and Phoenix. She added the ordinance now puts additional restrictions on illicit massage parlors and allows for more flexibility to the police department when investigating illicit massage parlors.

Committeemember Thompson requested that the Mesa Police Department fill the detective position that is vacant within the HEat Unit and add more officers.

Mr. Pombier stated that the department will collaborate on ways to better address the issue and find ways to add additional funding and staff to the HEat Unit.

Angie Bayless, communications consultant for the Arizona State University Office of Sex Trafficking Intervention and Research, supports the HEat unit and has worked with the HEat unit the last four years. She commended the City for investing in the HEat unit and provided statistics on sex trafficking. She stated her appreciation for the HEat unit and the efforts put forth to fight sex trafficking in the community.

Chairman Glover thanked staff for the presentation.

2-b. Hear a presentation and discuss the enforcement and adjudication of incidents relating to the current noise ordinance and provide a recommendation on any changes to the ordinance.

Assistant Chief Ken Cost introduced Commander Jeff Cutler and displayed a PowerPoint presentation. **(See Attachment 3)**

Assistant Chief Cost defined the noise ordinance and identified the prohibited noises. He detailed an officer's actions when a noise complaint is submitted, and the penalties associated with the fines. He also provided noise disturbance statistics and reviewed the policy and training given to officers.

In response to a question posed by Committeemember Freeman, Assistant City Manager John Pombier advised staff will review the noise ordinance to make sure it is easy to understand and there is no ambiguity.

Assistant City Attorney MaryGracy McNear added there is some archaic language within the ordinance and currently the ordinance is written so that officers have flexibility and can apply the ordinance based on different situations.

Committeemember Thompson agreed that the language in the ordinance needs to be reviewed so it is clear to understand, and residents and officers know what to expect when it comes to noise levels.

Mr. Pombier advised staff will change the language in the current ordinance and present the changes to the Committee at a future meeting.

Chairman Glover thanked staff for the presentation.

3. Adjournment.

Without objection, the Public Safety Committee meeting adjourned at 11:24 a.m.

Mesa Police Department

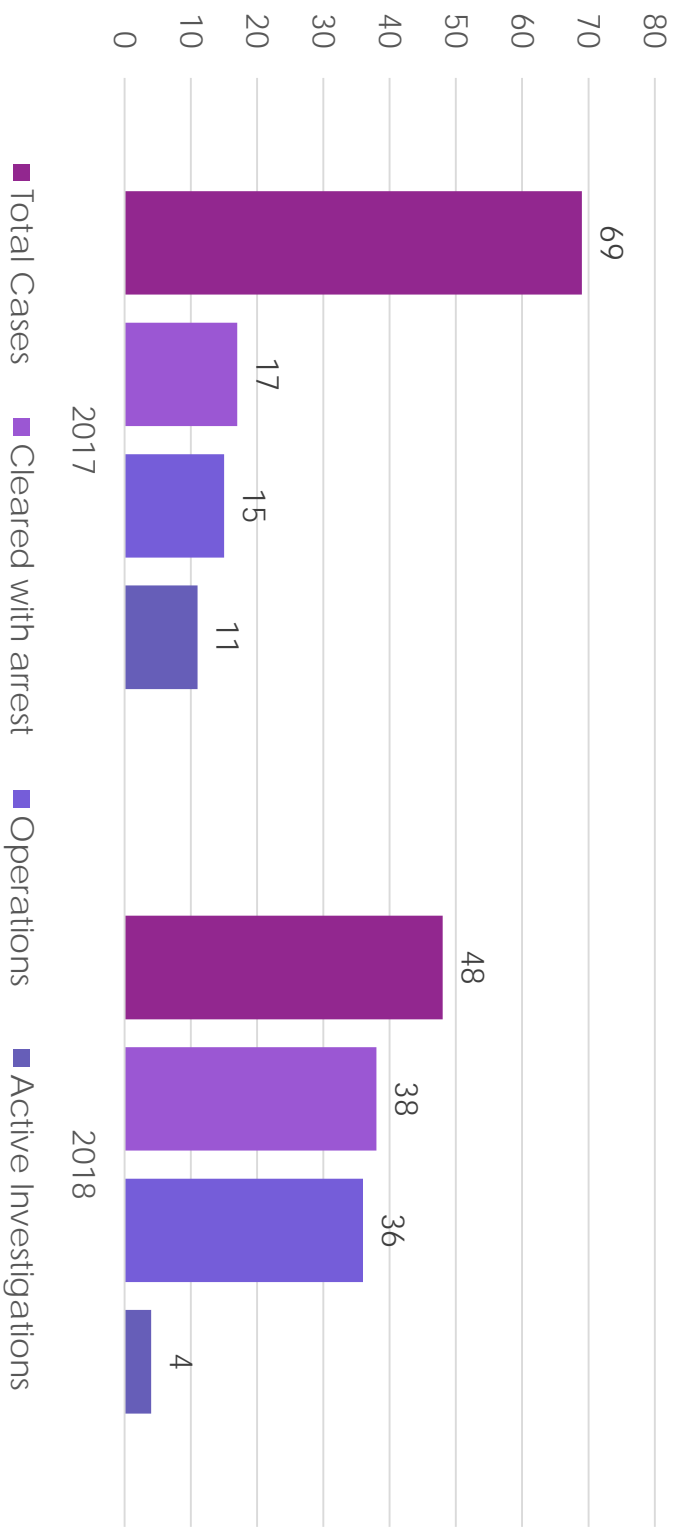
Human Trafficking:

- Mission: The HEAT Unit engages in a multi-disciplinary, comprehensive, and proactive approach to Human Exploitation and Trafficking through investigation, prevention, education, and advocacy.
 - Current Staffing: 1 Sergeant, 1 Detective, 1 Investigator and 1 Detective Vacancy.
- Human trafficking is form of modern-day slavery in which traffickers use force, fraud, or coercion to control victims.
- The majority of Human Trafficking cases are Sex Trafficking cases.
- The Mesa HEAT Unit identifies victims and traffickers in the Human Trafficking industry. Once the victim is identified, resources for victim(s) through victim services and community partners are provided.
- The HEAT Unit provides education and training internally to COM employees and externally to community partners, groups and at risk children.

- Missing Persons unit brought a case of run away juvenile and information of persons being trafficked in April 2017
 - Travelled to Tucson and El Paso, Texas
 - Ads posted on Backpage.com and street level prostitution
 - Phoenix PD, Arizona DPS, Tucson PD, Marana PD, El Paso PD (Texas), East Valley Fusion Center, Mesa Victim Services, AZ DCS, Juvenile Probation, Adult Probation, Mercy Maricopa Integrated Care (MMIC).
- Outcomes
 - 5 juveniles and 3 Adults rescued
 - 2 traffickers arrested
 - 16 search warrants executed
 - 2 Pen registries

Operation Rocket

- 2 day undercover operation to target the buyers (demand) of online prostitution
 - Undercover ads posted on backpage.com
- Outcomes
 - 21 arrests
 - Additional deals for illegal sex acts for money were arranged but detectives were unable to keep up with the demand
 - 470 persons responded to the undercover ads

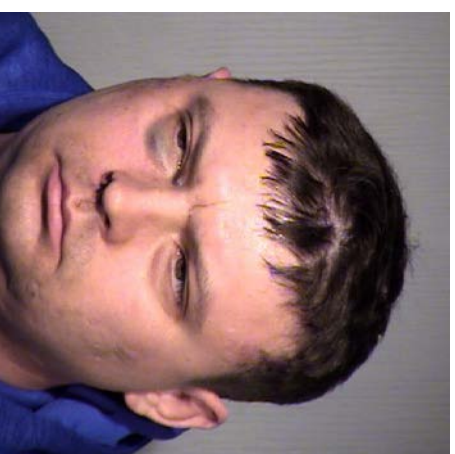

 - Demanded sex acts to occur in a public place
 - Was wearing a court ordered ankle monitor from a previous child prostitution conviction
- Charges filed from this investigation
 - 3 counts of aggravated assault on law enforcement
 - 2 counts of criminal damage
 - Resisting arrest and hindering prosecution
 - Prostitution

Noise Ordinance – Mesa City Code 6-12

- Certain noise levels must be tolerated – code does not apply to ordinary every day noise
- Standard is based on reasonableness
- Loud noise that is excessive or disruptive is prohibited

May 10, 2018



Mesa City Code 6-12-2 Prohibited Noises Standard

Noise that is loud, excessive, or disruptive is prohibited from:

- **Electronic devices**
- **Vehicles**

- Advise the concerned parties of the violation,
- Seek to gain voluntary compliance,
or
- Issue a civil citation and complete the appropriate Department Report

Levels of Responsibility

All of the following are eligible to receive a civil citation:

(Should be cited according to this hierarchy in most circumstances)

- 1st Noise Maker
- 2nd Event Sponsor
- 3rd Home Owner / Property Manager
- 4th Any person in attendance

Penalty

- Graduated Fine:
 - 1st violation - \$250.00
 - 2nd violation - \$500.00
 - 3rd violation - \$2,500.00
- Recovery costs for law enforcement are at the discretion of the Court

Officer's Observations must include:

- Level of noise;
- Nature of noise (usual or unusual);
- Origin of noise (natural or unnatural);
- Level and intensity of any background noise;
- Proximity of the noise to sleeping facilities;
- Nature and zoning of the area;
- Time of day or night the noise occurs;
- Duration of the noise;
- Whether the noise is recurrent, intermittent or constant;
- Whether the noise is produced by commercial or non-commercial activity.

The Mesa City Council passed a new noise ordinance on August 24, 2009.

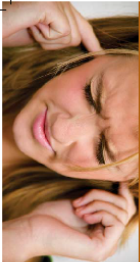
This ordinance is designed to protect neighborhood safety and reduce threats to the public peace, health, safety or general welfare. The ordinance addresses many types of noise, including parties and social gatherings or events, which result in disturbing the peace and quiet enjoyment of our community.

WHAT DOES THE NOISE ORDINANCE INCLUDE?

The standard is based on reasonableness and is applied to all noise that is excessive or disruptive and is not limited to electronic devices, vehicles, animals and people.

If the noise is intermittent or continuous for a period of at least 15 minutes, OR if it is after 10:00 p.m. but before 6:00 a.m., AND exceeds the property line, AND disturbs the peace and quiet of the neighborhood, AND causes any annoyance or inconvenience, it can be considered a violation of the ordinance.

This ordinance does not apply to every day noise that allows for normal functions of city life to continue. Exemptions can be made on a temporary basis and granted on a case-by-case basis by the City.



All infractions can include cost recovery for law enforcement at the discretion of the court.

DISRUPTIVE PARTY NOISE

A "disruptive party, gathering or event" means a group of two or more persons who have assembled or are assembling on any private property, including property used to conduct business, in a manner that is disruptive to the peace, health, safety or general welfare of the neighborhood, or a reasonably person of normal sensibilities, and/or creates noise as described in the ordinance.

WHAT HAPPENS IF A CITIZEN CALLS THE POLICE?

You can remain anonymous when you call. If the activity is determined to be a threat to the peace, health, safety or general welfare of the public, an officer will respond to the gathering and will issue an order to the responsible party or parties.

to immediately disperse the gathering.

In addition to the order of dispersal, the officer(s) can arrest the offenders for violations of state law or local ordinance. Depending on the circumstances, the owner, property manager, the person making the noise, a sponsor or sponsors of an event, and any person in attendance, they can all receive a violation. The first violation includes a fine of \$250.00 for each individual or entity responsible.

WHAT HAPPENS IF POLICE RESPOND A SECOND OR SUBSEQUENT TIME?

If police respond a second or subsequent time, the responsible parties will receive a civil citation for \$250.00. A second call resulting in a violation has a fine of \$2,500.00.
