Subject: One-Year Renewal to the Term Contract for Emergency Pump Rental Services for the Transportation Department **(Citywide)**

Recommendation

Council is requested to approve the contract renewal as recommended.

The Transportation Department and Purchasing recommend authorizing the renewal with Water Movers, Inc. (Primary); and Western Oilfields Supply Company dba Rain for Rent (Secondary); for \$100,000.00, based on estimated usage.

Background

The Transportation Department maintains 39 storm water pump stations with 51 of the pumps that convey storm water, irrigation tail water, and water from storm events.

This contract provides for emergency trailer mounted pump rental along with associated equipment and hardware on an as-needed basis, 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. It would mitigate flooding in an emergency and supports City equipment down for repairs. The contractor is required to be able to provide a minimum of 6 pumps, 4" inches or bigger, and associated equipment at the same time. The contractor is responsible for delivery, set-up, and pick-up of all rental equipment.

Water Movers, Inc. (Primary) and Rain for Rent (Secondary) agreed to renew the contract under the same terms, conditions and current pricing. Both contractors have performed exceptionally well, the equipment is up to date and personnel is experienced. The Consumer Price Index (CPI) increased 2.1% over the last year. Rebidding this contract would likely expose the City to higher prices for these services. This contract continues to be advantageous to the City and it is in the City's best interest to renew the contract.
