## RESOLUTION NO.

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH THE FEDERAL BUREAU OF INVESTIGATION FOR THE SHARING OF RADIO COMMUNICATIONS SITES AND FACILITIES.

WHEREAS, The Federal Bureau of Investigation is in need of radio coverage which is not presently available to them; and

WHEREAS, The Federal Bureau of Investigation is seeking permission to install communication equipment at the City's communication site located at Shaw Butte; and

WHEREAS, this equipment will be used in support of investigative operations for the United States Department of Justice; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement for the establishment of modern and reliable radio communications systems with the Federal Bureau of Investigation; and

WHEREAS, this Agreement applies to all Sites where space and technical parameters allows the improved interoperability and coverage of each municipality's radio system.

## NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, MARICOPA COUNTY, STATE OF ARIZONA:

<u>Section 1</u>: That the Council of the City of Mesa approves the Intergovernmental Agreement between the City and the Federal Bureau of Investigation and any Site Specific Supplemental Agreements arising out of the Intergovernmental Agreement for the sharing of communication sites.

Section 2. That the City Manager is authorized and directed to enter into the Intergovernmental Agreement between the City of Mesa and The Federal Bureau of Investigation and any site-specific supplement agreements arising out of this Intergovernmental Agreement for the sharing of communication sites.
