A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR HIS DESIGNEE TO ENTER INTO A GRANT AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF TUCSON TO ACCEPT \$52,000 IN GRANT FUNDS UNDER THE HIGH INTENSITY DRUG TRAFFICKING AREA (HIDTA) PROGRAM TO BE USED FOR OVERTIME FOR THE POLICE DEPARTMENT'S VIOLENT OFFENDER UNIT.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA,

MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Authorizing and directing the City Manager, or his designee, to enter into a Grant Agreement, and any related amendments or supplements thereto, with the City of Tucson to accept \$52,000 in grant funds under the High Intensity Drug Trafficking Area (HIDTA) Program. The funds will be used for overtime for the Police Department's Violent Offender Unit.

<u>Section 2</u>: Approval by the City Attorney or designee and signature by the City Manager or designee of the Grant Agreement, and any related amendments or supplements thereto, shall constitute conclusive evidence of this City Council's approval thereof.
