## RESOLUTION NO.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE ARIZONA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND THE CITY OF MESA FOR THE PLANNING AND FUTURE ALIGNMENT FOR A MULTI-USE PATHWAY ON THE STATE ROUTE 24 FREEWAY BETWEEN ELLSWORTH AND MERIDIAN ROADS.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA,

## MARICOPA COUNTY, AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1:</u> Approving the Intergovernmental Agreement between the Arizona Department of Transportation (ADOT) and the City of Mesa which identifies the responsibilities of ADOT and the City for the designation of an alignment for a future multiuse pathway along the SR24 corridor and to negotiate a Future Agreement that addresses the pathway costs, roles and maintenance responsibilities.

Section 2: That the City Manager, Christopher J. Brady, or his designated representative, is authorized and directed to enter into the Intergovernmental Agreement, and any related amendments or supplements thereto, on behalf of the City of Mesa, and the City Clerk is authorized and directed to attest to the signature of the City Manager or his authorized designated representative thereon. The City Manager is further authorized to approve minor, administrative, technical, procedural and non-material modifications to the agreement and all of its exhibits, as needed.
