Subject: Three-Year Term Contract with Two Years Renewal Options for Mainline and Shortline Pavement Marking Services for the Transportation Department
(Citywide)

Recommendation

Council is requested to approve the award as recommended.

The Transportation Department and Purchasing recommend awarding the contract to the lowest, responsive and responsible bidder, MRM Construction Services, Inc. for \$368,040.00 annually with an annual increase allowance of up to 5% or the adjusted Consumer Price Index.

Background / Discussion

This contract will provide for the installation and removal of mainline and short line pavement marking services on an as-needed basis. Mainline and short line markings are used for traffic control throughout the City. Mainline pavement markings include lane lines, center lines and edge lines installed with thermoplastic or waterborne traffic paint. Shortline pavement markings include traffic marking symbols and legends installed with waterborne paint, thermoplastic or preformed tape.
