Subject: Approving and Authorizing the City Manager to Execute the Second

Amendment to the TOPAZ Regional Wireless Cooperative (TRWC) Amended and Restated Intergovernmental Agreement (Citywide)

Recommendation

The Information Technology Department, as the Administrative Manager for the TRWC, and the Board of Directors of the TRWC, recommends approving and authorizing the City Manager to enter into the Second Amendment to the Amended and Restated Intergovernmental Agreement to Plan, Design, Construct, Operate, Maintain, and Finance the TOPAZ Regional Wireless Cooperative Network.

Background / Discussion

The original TRWC Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) was established on August 7, 2008. The Amended and Restated IGA, dated May 1, 2012, superseded the original IGA in its entirety, and added the Rio Verde Fire District as a member of the TRWC. The First Amendment to the Amended and Restated IGA, dated February 1, 2016, added the Fort McDowell Yavapai Nation as a member of the TRWC.

The Second Amendment to the Amended and Restated IGA, which will become effective December 1, 2018, provides the following major improvements to the TRWC Governance Agreement, which is attached as Exhibit A to the Second Amendment to the Amended and Restated IGA:

- 1) Simplifies and streamlines the governance language and document organization
- 2) Allows for adoption of policies and procedures for improved adaptability over time
- 3) Updates voting provisions to include supermajority voting on high-impact items
- 4) Improves member admission provisions and streamlines the admission process

Alternatives

Council may elect to take no action, which would leave the First Amendment to the Amended and Restated IGA in effect.

Fiscal Impact

There is no fiscal impact to the City of Mesa or the other members of the TRWC as a result of adopting the Second Amendment to the Amended and Restated IGA.
