Subject:	Three-Year Term Contract with Two Years of Renewal Options for Emergency Response and Non-Emergency Response for Unknown, Hazardous and Non-Hazardous Materials for the Environmental Management and Sustainability Department (Citywide)

Recommendation

Council is requested to approve the award as recommended.

A committee representing Environmental Management and Sustainability Department and Purchasing evaluated responses. The evaluation committee recommends awarding the contract to the qualified proposals from Kary Environmental Services, Inc. (a Mesa business) (Primary); and Environmental Response, Inc. (Secondary); at \$80,000 annually with an annual increase allowance of up to 5% or the adjusted Consumer Price Index.

Background / Discussion

This contract will provide services for two Scopes of Work:

- Emergency response (ER), cleanup and disposal of unknown, hazardous and non-hazardous materials for the City of Mesa; and
- Non-emergency response (NER), cleanup and disposal of unknown, hazardous and non-hazardous materials for the City of Mesa.

The City received two proposals of which both met the minimum qualifications. Due to receiving only two responses, the evaluation team evaluated each response using a simple comparative analysis as allowed for in the solicitation. The evaluation team recommends a dual award: Kary Environmental, Inc., as the Primary award; and Environmental Response, Inc. (ERI), as the Secondary provider. The evaluation team unanimously agreed on the recommendation.
