- B. Supplemental Notice of Funding Availability (NOFA) Dennis Newburn discussed the 2018 Supplemental Notice of Funding Availability (NOFA), which opened September 30, 2018, and closes at 12:00 p.m. on November 1, 2018. The NOFA will be funded with approximately \$700,000 in federal

Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) dollars allocated to the City of Mesa from the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) from previous program years. This NOFA applies to CDBG-eligible activities funded under the categories of *Public Facilities and Improvements*, *Economic Development*, and *Accessibility*. Activities funded with CDBG funds must benefit persons principally of low- and moderate-income. Two public meetings are scheduled: Public Hearing #1 — October 15, 2018, 4:00 p.m.; Public Hearing #2 — October 22, 2018, 6:00 p.m. Both meetings will be held at Save the Family Conference Center, 129 E. C. HOME Program Overview — Ra'Chel'Ni Mar'Na gave an overview of the City's HOME Investment Partnership Program. The primary purpose of the HOME Program is to help communities expand the affordable housing for low-income families. Due to the complexity of planning and development real estate developments, it was necessary to open the City's HOME Housing Production applications year-round.
