FIRST AMENDMENT TO INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT FOR THE HOUSING CHOICE VOUCHER VETERAN AFFAIRS SUPPORTIVE HOUSING PROGRAM BETWEEN THE MESA HOUSING AUTHORITY AND PINAL COUNTY HOUSING AUTHORITY

This First Amendment to Intergovernmental Agreement ("<u>First Amendment</u>") is entered into this ____ day of _____, 2018, by and between the Pinal County Housing Authority, an Arizona Housing Authority ("<u>PHA</u>"), and the City of Mesa, an Arizona municipal corporation, on behalf of the Mesa Housing Authority ("<u>MHA</u>"). The parties to this Agreement may be referred to collectively as the "parties" and individually as a "party".

RECITALS:

- A. On May 22, 2015, the parties entered into an Intergovernmental Agreement for the Housing Choice Voucher Veteran Affairs Supportive Housing Program between the Mesa Housing Authority and the Pinal County Housing Authority ("<u>Agreement</u>"), related to the use of rental assistance vouchers for homeless veterans and their families in the Pinal County, Arizona.
- B. The parties now desire to amend said Agreement to extend the term and allow for automatic renewals.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing premises and mutual promises and agreements of the parties, the parties agree to amend the Agreement as follows:

1. Section 3 of the Agreement shall be amended to extend the term of the Agreement as follows (**bold** reflects additions, strikethrough reflects struck language):

"3. TERM

The term of this Agreement shall begin on the date first written above and will remain in effect through June 30, 2017 June 30, 2020 unless terminated as provided herein. If agreed by the parties, this Agreement may be extended two times for a period of one year each time. At the end of the initial term, the Agreement may be automatically extended twice, each for a one (1) year term, unless a party gives notice to the other party of a desire not to renew the Agreement thirty (30) days prior to the termination of the then current term."

2. All other terms and conditions of the Agreement shall remain unchanged, and in full force and effect.
