Subject: 10-Month Term Contract with Four Years of Renewal Options for Fire

Extinguishers and Related Services for the Fire and Medical Department

(Citywide)

Recommendation

Council is requested to approve the award as recommended.

The Fire and Medical Department and Purchasing recommend authorizing the purchase using the State of Arizona cooperative contract with Cintas Corporation at \$60,000 annually with an annual increase allowance of up to 5% or the adjusted Consumer Price Index.

Background / Discussion

This contract will provide for the purchase, inspection, testing, service and maintenance of portable fire extinguishers for citywide facilities.

The State contract has been competitively bid and provides for the lowest possible cooperative pricing. Staff has been satisfied with the contract's products and services. Staff compared three cooperative contracts and the State contract was deemed to be the most cost-effective contract to use for the City. Going out for a formal bid would delay the purchase and would not result in any cost savings to the City.
