Subject: Ratification of the Emergency Purchase for the Presidential Rally as requested by the Police Department **(Citywide)**

Recommendation

Council is requested to approve the emergency purchase as recommended.

The Police Department and Purchasing recommend ratifying the purchase from the contract with Pride Group, LLC at \$44,241.90.

Background / Discussion

This emergency purchase provided parking and security services related to the Trump Rally held at Phoenix Mesa Gateway Airport on 10/19/2018.

Pride Group, LLC provided light towers, parking control equipment, dust control, golf carts, dispatch, tables, watch station, communications equipment, lot striping, etc., and invoiced \$58,049.66 for these items. The City of Mesa and Phoenix Mesa Gateway Airport agreed to split and each paid half of the invoice amount (\$29,024.83). In addition, the City expended \$15,217.07 for security services, event parking control services, and trash/recycle containers.

The emergency purchase was approved by the City Manager's office as provided in the City Code.
