Subject: One-Year Renewal to the Term Contract for Rodder/Vacuum Sewer Truck

Parts and Services for the Fleet Services Department (Citywide)

Recommendation

Council is requested to approve the contract renewal as recommended.

The Fleet Services Department and Purchasing recommend authorizing the renewal using the Pima County cooperative contract with AZ Wastewater Industries, Inc. for \$87,500.

Background / Discussion

This contract provides rodder/vacuum sewer truck parts and services for repairs and maintenance of the City's fleet.

The Pima County cooperative contract was competitively bid, meets procurement requirements and prices are competitive due to regional volume contract pricing. It is unlikely that competitive bidding would result in better pricing than through this cooperative contract. The City has been satisfied with the vendor's performance. This contract continues to be advantageous to the City and it is in the City's best interest to renew the contract.
