Subject: Purchase of Storage Infrastructure Hardware to Upgrade/Expand Data Storage Capacity for the Information Technology Department (Funded by Lifecycle Funds) (Citywide)

## Recommendation

Council is requested to approve the award as recommended.
The Information Technology Department and Purchasing recommend authorizing the purchase using the State of Arizona cooperative contract with the lowest quoted vendor, iT1 Source, for $\$ 137,519.29$.

## Background / Discussion

The Nimble storage arrays provide fast data storage for critical on premise (non-cloud) City applications. The existing storage systems have performed as expected but require more processing power to fully utilize the storage capacity in the coming years.

This purchase will upgrade two Nimble storage systems to the next generation of storage controller to provide more processing power and memory. The main reason for the upgrade is to prepare for the migration of data from aging storage in preparation for the retirement of those older storage platforms.

Using the cooperative contract provides the City an advantage in pricing due to volume of sales and discounts.
