A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA. MARICOPA APPROVING AND COUNTY. ARIZONA. AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR HIS DESIGNEE TO ENTER INTO A PEDESTRIAN AND BICYCLIST SUB-GRANTEE COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT WITH THE ARIZONA GOVERNOR'S OFFICE OF HIGHWAY SAFETY TO ACCEPT \$30,000 IN GRANT FUNDS. THE FUNDS WILL BE USED BY THE POLICE DEPARTMENT'S TRAFFIC DIVISION FOR OVERTIME. EMPLOYEE RELATED EXPENSES AND SUPPLIES FOR PEDESTRIAN AND BICYCLE SAFETY THROUGHOUT THE CITY OF MESA.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, MARICOPA

COUNTY, ARIZONA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Authorizing the City Manager, or his designee, to enter into a Pedestrian and Bicyclist Sub-Grantee Cooperative Agreement, and any related amendments or supplements thereto, with the Arizona Governor's Office of Highway Safety to accept \$30,000, in grant funds. The funds will be used by the Police Department's Traffic Division for overtime, employee related expenses and supplies for pedestrian and bicycle safety throughout the City of Mesa.

<u>Section 2</u>: Approval by the City Attorney or designee and signature by the City Manager or designee of the Pedestrian and Bicyclist Sub-Grantee Cooperative Agreement, and any related amendments or supplements thereto, shall constitute conclusive evidence of this City Council's approval thereof.
